## IN GENERAL ASSEMBLY

JANUARY SESSION, A. D. 19 79.

### AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 50(h) of Chapter 832 of the Public Laws, 1940 entitled "An Act to Revise, Consolidate and Amend Chapter 598 of the Public Laws of 1866, entitled 'An Act to Revise, Consolidate and Amend the Act, entitled "An Act to Incorporate the City of Providence," and the Several Acts in Addition Thereto and in Amendment Thereof' and the Several Acts in Addition Thereto and in Amendment Thereof", is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 50. POWERS AND DUTIES.--

"\* \* \*

"Pass upon all ordinances and resolutions adopted by the council, either approving or withholding approval of the same, and in his discretion veto any ordinance or resolution and veto or reduce any item or items of appropriation, subject in all cases to the power of the council to pass the same over his veto, as hereinbefore provided:

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
