Approved November 9, 1978

WHEREAS, On October 20, 1978, a raging fire erupted at 130 Oxford Street, wherein several occupants resided, and

WHEREAS, Passerby Samuel Wilson, noting the building afire, rushed through the building, informing the occupants who were unaware of their danger, to vacate the building, and

WHEREAS, Residents unable to leave their apartments normally, were urged to jump from windows, Samuel Wilson catching a leaping woman, aided by Corey Morris and a Security Policeman of the Housing Authority, Donald Collins, catching a leaping woman and child, and

WHEREAS, Firefighters at the scene heroically rescued several children from the flaming building through smoke filled stairways and by ladders, jeopardizing their lives,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That to Samuel Wilson, Corey Morris and Donald Collins and to Providence's firefighters, the Members of this City Council express their sincere and deep appreciation for their respective unselfish and fearless acts of bravery, for the lives they saved.
