No. 165 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 24-7 (a) AND (b) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, ENTITLED: "LICENSE FEES".

Approved March 26, 1981

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 24-7 (a) and (b) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 24-7 License fees.

(a) VEHICLES. For every license granted for vehicles used for the conveyance of persons or things for hire, there shall be paid the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00), provided, that for every license so granted for automobiles, motor cars or other power-driven vehicles (except railroad and railway cars and motor vehicles running only upon rails or tracks), used for the conveyance of passengers for hire, there shall be paid the sum of twenty dollars (\$20.00).

(b) DRIVERS. For every license so granted to persons to drive and have charge of any vehicle for hire, there shall be paid the sum of five dollars (\$5.00).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
