

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved December 9, 1976

WHEREAS, two recent accidents, resulting in injuries to pedestrians, one fatally, did occur at the intersection of Branch Avenue and Hawkins Street, and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the sponsors of this Resolution, Councilman James A. Petrosinelli and Councilman Robert V. Salvatore, that the said accidents may have been avoided, if that intersection had been controlled by motor vehicle traffic signal lights,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Traffic Engineer is requested to give priority to the installation of motor vehicle traffic signal lights at the intersection of Branch Avenue with Hawkins Street.
