Dept. - Engineering Office, City Property Section, Plan No. 061535, Date November 28, 1956" has ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Superintendent of Street Signs and Numbers be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed at each end of Arizona Street, abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, that after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper, published in the County of Providence, at least once each week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting upon said Arizona Street, which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.

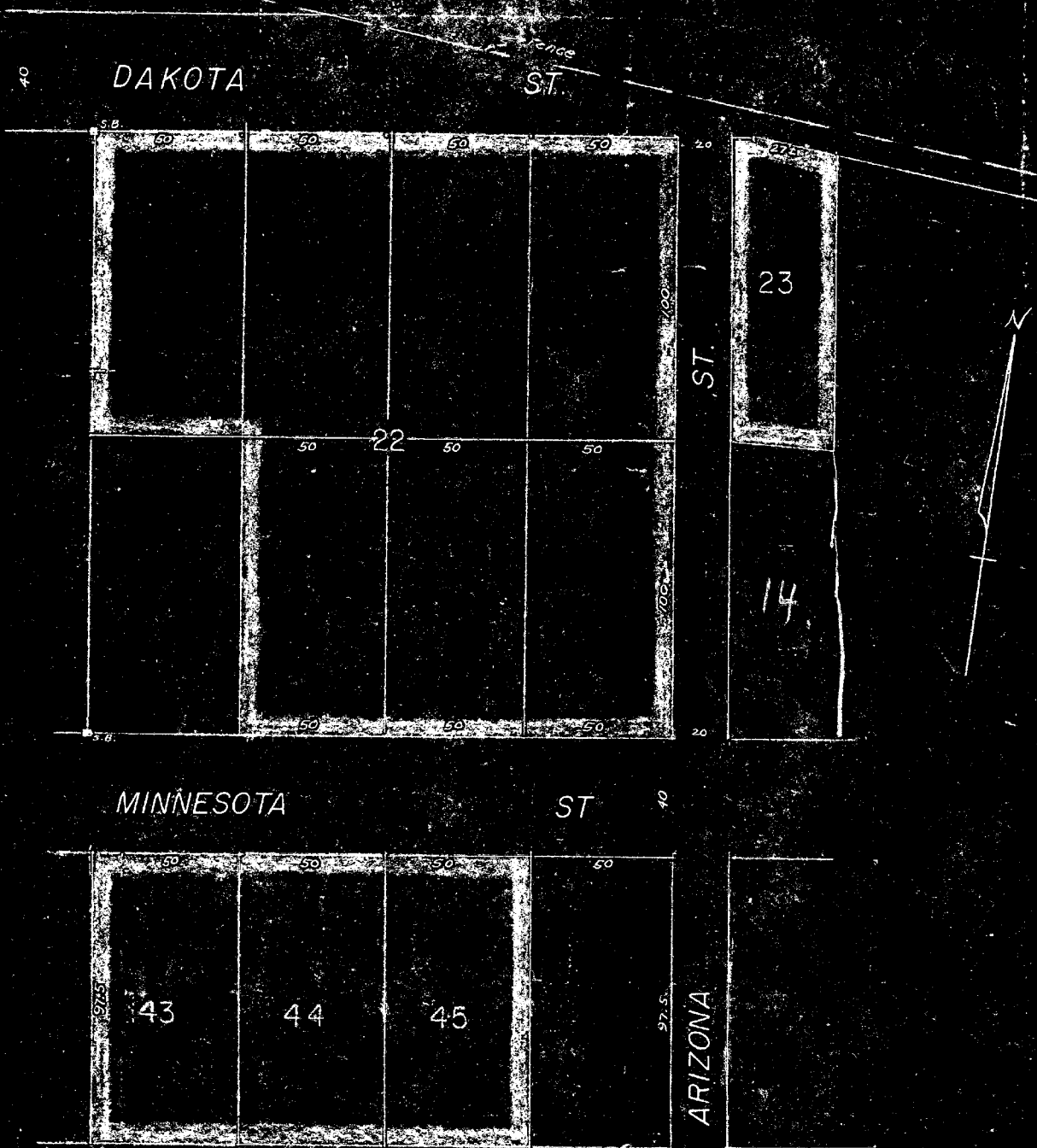

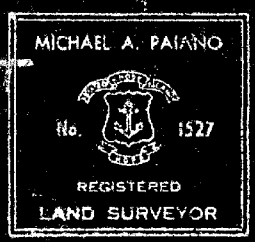

This referral is a request for the abandonment of Arizona Street.


On the field trip it was found that the street in question lies between Minnesota and Dakota Streets. Much of the surrounding area is in vegetation.



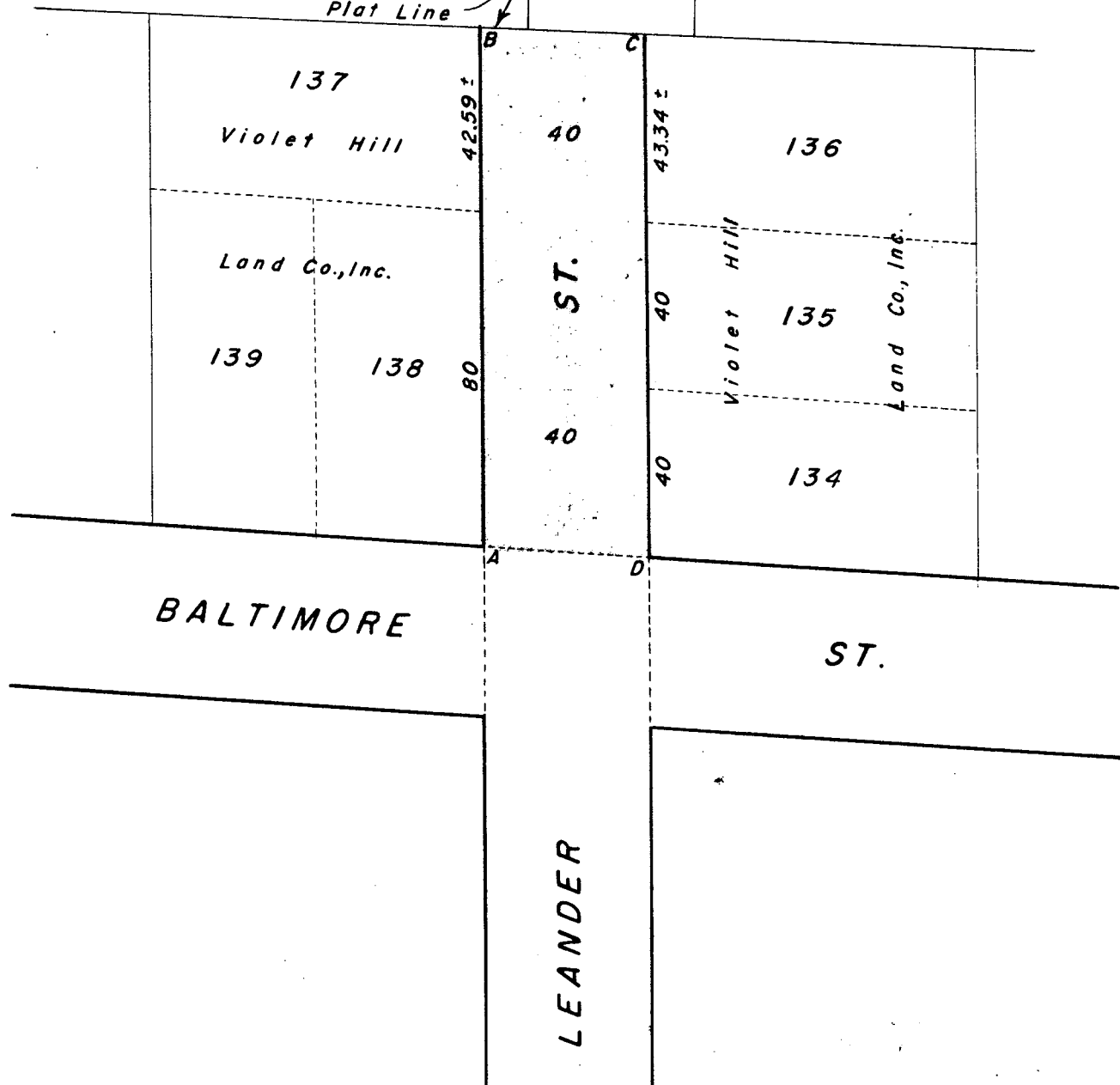
