Approved December 26, 1976

WHEREAS, Israel P. Pearlman, prominent community leader, has passed from this life, and

WHEREAS, a devoted husband and father, much of his adult life was devoted to Jewish causes, with affiliations locally and regionally, a dedication for which he was recognized and appreciated, and

WHEREAS, strong in the belief that maintaining a healthy body, an academic mind, his devotion to his God and his religion, he maintained a high level of good conduct and behavior, and

WHEREAS, a graduate of the University of Michigan, Class of 1920, Mr. Pearlman, an immigrant from his native Poland in 1898, rewarded the community by his legacy of eleven children, forty grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren, each a living monument to his principles,
