

I am writing to request that the following requested contract award be submitted to the City Council and the Finance Committee for approval.

- *Information Technology* – Approval of a request to pay Precision Power LLC - a sole source vendor – to design additional network connections throughout office at 444 Westminster Street at an amount of \$7,850.
- *Police Department* – Approval of a request to pay Cop Logic Inc – a sole source vendor – to provide an online resource for the members of the public seeking to report and document an incident.


DATA CABLING INSTALLATION AT 444 WESTMINSTER ST.

The Information Technology Department has been working with the owner of the City Administration building at 444 Westminster Street to design additional network connections throughout offices on all three floors. These connections will service the new staff in the Inspection and Standards offices, support networked credit card terminals at the service counter, replace faulty wiring for Planning staff, and support additional wireless access points in the Law Department. The building owner has directed the City to work with Precision Power, LLC, as their preferred electrical and low-voltage wiring vendor.

The IT Department has negotiated a rate of \$7,850.00 for this work, and is requesting a sole-source award of this contract to Precision Power, LLC. This vendor has experience wiring the existing offices within the building, has staff familiar with the wiring layout, and has been prequalified by the building owner to perform construction work within their facility. The vendor will be responsible for any required permits to do this work.

Funds are available through the Information Technology Budget, in Account Code # 101-204-52905, and the cap is \$7,850 in Fiscal Year 2016.
