It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The general assembly hereby appropriates to the city
- 2 of Providence out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropri-
- 3 ated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1986, the sum of fifty thou-
- 4 sand dollars (\$50,000.00), pursuant to the provisions of section
- 5 44-5-11.4 entitled "Property tax assessment -- Technology grants," to
- 6 establish and implement a model computer demonstration program for the
- 7 purposes of city and town property tax administration, and the state
- 8 controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his orders upon
- 9 the general treasurer for the payment of such sum or so much thereof
- 10 as may be required upon receipt by him of proper vouchers approved by
- 11 the director of community affairs.
