RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 1173

Approved December 14, 1979

WHEREAS, The Providence Civic Center Authority, in a true concern for possible detrimental effects to the Community, has voted to cancel a previously scheduled Rock Concert on December 17, 1979, and

WHEREAS, Several members of the Providence City Council feel this concerned attitude and subsequent decision was premature and could result in displaying a bad faith attitude and possibly working towards the detriment of future appearances by enterainers thereby causing financial hardship to the Providence Civic Center, and,

WHEREAS, The Rock Group, "The Who", has performed without incident in Buffalo, New York and is scheduled in several other Cities in the United States, and

WHEREAS, Several Members of the Providence City Council are of the opinion that the Rock Group "The Who" would not constitute a provocative situation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence Civic Center Authority is hereby requested to reconsider its action in regards to cancelling the scheduled Concert performed by the Rock Group "The Who" thereby allowing the Concert to be performed as scheduled.
