# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 334

Approved April 11, 1979

WHEREAS, Martin Luther King, Jr. was not only a great leader of the Black People of these United States but also was a great American, and

WHEREAS, Martin Luther King <sup>JR</sup> was unyielding in his search for Equality, Justice and Peace for all mankind, and

WHEREAS, Martin Luther King, Jr. and others of his courage and stamina and dedication made great strides in the fight for Freedom and Peace, and

WHEREAS, He contributed much to our lives and left much that was good and desirable for us to emulate and while he is no longer with us, the good that he did lives on,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council takes note of this tragic incident and others like it which has deprived us of some of our greatest leaders, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Council pauses in its deliberations to Honor the memory of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
