JANUARY SESSION, A. D. 19 53.

AN ACT

TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS TO RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY
OF PROVIDENCE.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Providence is hereby authorized to pay to each retired employee of the City who has been in the service of the City at least twenty-five (25) years, an amount which added to all other income received by such employee from any source whatsoever, ~~including any retirement allowance or pension from the City of Providence,~~ shall assure such employee a monthly income of an amount to be fixed by the City Council or Committee designated by it, but in no event more than one hundred twenty-five (\$125) dollars.

SEC. 2. Any payment made by the City under the terms of this act shall be deemed a gratuity and not a matter of right. The City Council may, in its discretion, revoke, suspend or alter any such payment.

SEC. 3. The City Council shall appropriate from time to time from the general funds of the City such sums as may be necessary for the purposes of this act. Appropriations so made shall not be deducted from the funds of any existing pension or retirement system nor credited against any contributions or payments made or required to be made by the City to such pension system.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
