RESOLVED, That His Honor the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a deed of conveyance to Grinnell Corporation, or its nominee, of that certain area of land known as the Garibaldi Playground property and located on the northwesterly corner of Brayton Avenue and Cedar Street and being designated as Lot two hundred thirty-seven (237) on Assessor's Plat twenty-six (26), containing approximately 55,025 square feet, in consideration of a payment of THIRTY THOUSAND (\$30,000.00) DOLLARS,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Resolution of the City Council Number 773, approved December 24, 1965, is hereby rescinded.

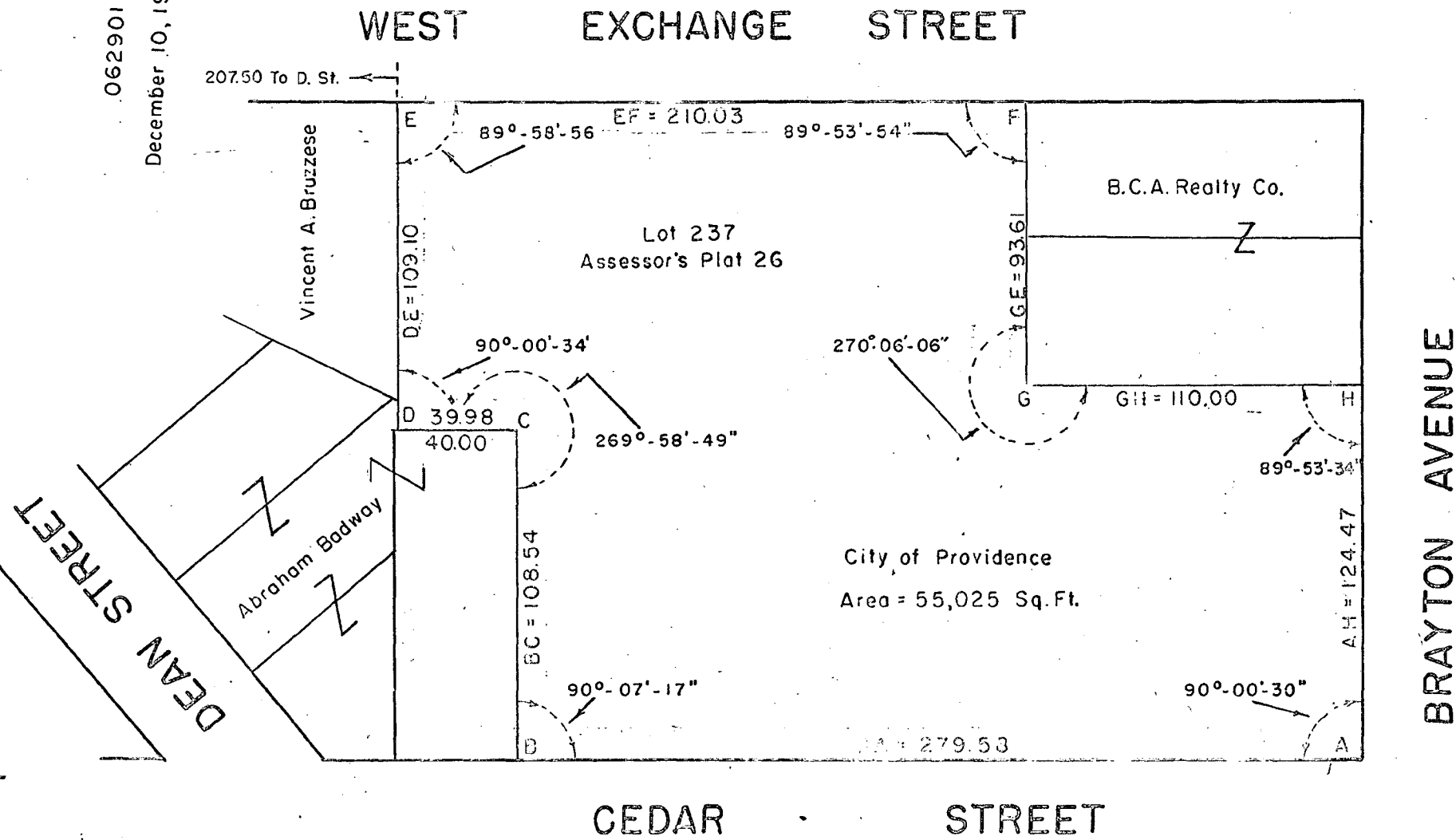

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 52

Approved January 22, 1966

Resolved,

**That** His Honor the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a deed of conveyance to McLaughlin & Moran, Inc., a Rhode Island corporation, of Lot 276 on City Assessor's Plat 56, so identified as of December 31, 1965, and being located at Fields Point, Providence, Rhode Island, the area to be conveyed containing 183,659 square feet, and the consideration to be paid being thirty (.30) cents per square foot, or a total sum of FIFTY-FIVE THOUSAND NINETY-SEVEN and 70/100 (\$55,097.70) DOLLARS.

In further consideration of the proposed conveyance, the said McLaughlin & Moran, Inc. shall cause to be installed, at its own expense and without any cost to the City, any and all necessary sanitary facilities, and in particular a main drain or common sewer. In addition to the conveyance of said land, the City shall grant to the company an easement to cross and recross a strip of land of the City of approximately forty-one (41) feet in width by the entire length of the lot herein to be conveyed.
