EMERGENCY  
No. 22 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF THE APPROPRIATION  
ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1974-19, APPROVED JUNE 19, 1974, BY  
APPROPRIATING A SUM NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED NINE  
THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$109,200.00) TO ITEM O  
FOR SALARY ADJUSTMENT FOR MEMBERS OF THE BARGAINING  
UNIT OF THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, LODGE NO. 3.

Approved February 12, 1976

WHEREAS, for the purpose of implementing this appropriation pursuant to Sec. 3.18 of the Charter of the City of Providence, and in order to insure those employees who qualify for salary adjustments, that they not be unduly inconvenienced with additional delay of the said adjustment it is hereby declared that an emergency situation exists.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1974-19 of the Ordinances of the City Providence, as approved June 19, 1974 entitled "An Ordinance making appropriation of \$85,823,307.71 for the support of City Government for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 1974 and ending June 30, 1975" (July 1, 1975 - June 30, 1976) as amended is hereby further amended by appropriating sum not to exceed One Hundred Nine Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$109,200.00) to Item O for salary adjustment for Members of the bargaining unit of the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge No. 3.

SECTION 2. The said sum not to exceed One Hundred Nine Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$109,200.00) as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer such amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated Receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account are hereby increased by a sum not to exceed One Hundred Nine Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$109,200.00).

SECTION 4. This Emergency Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption by the Council and its Approval by the Mayor, in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 3.18 of the said Charter, and shall be retroactive to July 1, 1975.
