In Re: Pole #7 Relocation at #55 Gillen Street


After field investigating this utility pole relocation request, it was found this pole is not blocking the existing driveway; and if the property owner does have reasonable access to his property I cannot order the Utility Company to relocate their property (Poles, wires, Fixture, etc.) unless it is absolutely necessary.

Mr. Thomas Stanton, a Narragansett Electric Company field inspector, looked at this problem for me, on request, and stated he has been there on a previous call by property owner.

The pole is presently located approximately 4' off the curvature and the Utility Company classify this as an unnecessary expensive move.

However, Mr. Stanton informs me that if the property owner at #55 can establish, by a survey stake, where his true property line is, he shall recommend to his superiors at the Utility Company, that the pole in question be relocated to the property line, so it would not interfere with the adjoining property owners lot.
