

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 649

*Approved* September 29, 2000

WHEREAS, The Members of the City Council have a responsibility to the citizens of their neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS, The Members of the City Council do not currently receive notices or communication regarding applications for either Class F Liquor Licenses, or temporary liquor and entertainment licenses in their wards, and

WHEREAS, The Chief of the Providence Police Department, the Commissioner of Public Safety, the Superintendent of the Providence Parks Department, the Traffic Engineer and the Chief of the Providence Fire Department also do not receive notice of such applications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council requests that:

1. The Board of Licenses send immediate notice of any and all applications for Class F Liquor Licenses, and any and all temporary liquor and entertainment licenses to the councilperson representing the area in which the license is sought, Chief of the Providence Police Department, the Commissioner of Public Safety, the Superintendent of the Providence Parks Department, the Traffic Engineer and the Chief of the Providence Fire Department.
2. The Bureau of Licenses shall include on such notices the date, place, time and sponsoring organization(s) of said application.
3. Each of the individuals to whom such notices are addressed shall have 10 business days from the receipt thereof to reply.
4. The Bureau of Licenses shall review those responses in considering each application and notify the above-mentioned individuals of the decision thereof.
