A devout husband and father, Mario's devotion to his wife Mariaelena and their children DeLena, Samantha, Mario Jr., and Raquel reared with love and pride.

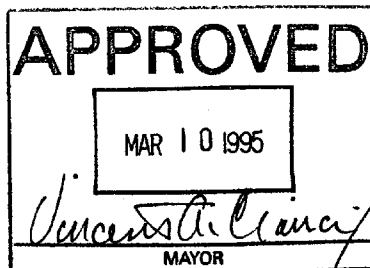

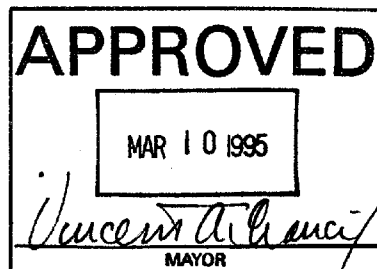
