RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 756

Approved September 22, 1975

WHEREAS, according to the last report of the City Controller, there is a total assessed valuation of vacant land and some buildings, acquired by the City at the tax sale of \$872,310.00, and

WHEREAS, it appears that if titles to the said properties were cleared, the same could be offered to persons who qualify, under the Provisions of that Ordinance recently adopted by the City Council on May 1, 1975, and approved by the Mayor on May 8, 1975, which authorizes the City of Providence to regulate a "Homestead Program",



