





RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 627

Approved November 13, 1967

WHEREAS, the cost of home heating oil has gone up in the City of Providence and in its metropolitan area, rather than going down as usual during the summer months; and

WHEREAS, all oil dealers are in agreement that the price of home heating oil will continue to rise substantially and that there may be a shortage thereof; and

WHEREAS, this metropolitan region and the other New England States are more dependent on heating oil for home heating than most other regions; and

WHEREAS, the supply of home heating oil for this region, and thus the price thereof, are under the control of the President of the United States acting through the Secretary of the Interior;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence, in behalf of the people of the City of Providence and the 481,614 people comprising its metropolitan region in the States of Rhode Island and Massachusetts, respectfully petitions the President of the United States to modify import controls on home heating oil so as to increase the supply thereof and thus prevent further increases in price which bear most heavily on low and middle income families.

That a copy hereof be sent to the Secretary of the Interior, Stewart L. Udall, and to The Honorable John O. Pastore, The Honorable Claiborne Pell, the Honorable Fernand St. Germain, and The Honorable Robert O. Tiernan, the representatives of the State in the United States Congress.
