

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved March 17, 1975

WHEREAS, this park is presently littered with debris and broken glass and other items which detract from its natural beauty, and

WHEREAS, many of the benches and seats provided in this park are presently in a state of disrepair,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Superintendent of Parks is requested to cause Lippitt Park be cleaned, and litter and debris of all kinds be removed and that all benches and seats in a state of disrepair be repaired and put in condition for use and enjoyment of the Citizens of Providence.
