TO THE HONORABLE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:
GENTLEMEN:

Your Committee, to which was referred the communication from the Commissioner of Public Safety in answer to Resolution 183 of 1955, which requested a study be made relative to the necessity of providing a fire boat for additional protection for property along the water front, respectfully reports:

Your Committee held a meeting on May 25, 1955, with Commander Arthur L. Hoglund, U.S. Coast Guard Officer in Charge of Marine Inspection for the Port of Providence; Mr. Frank Mauran, President of the Providence Steamboat Company; and Mr. Herman P. Sergeant, Vice-President of that Company.

Your Committee respectfully reports that the meeting was concerned with the possibility of enlisting the aid of privately-owned tow boats in the immediate area of the Providence Harbor and of the feasibility of undertaking the outfitting of these boats with fire-fighting equipment.

In its deliberations and with the advice of the above noted individuals who have had extensive experience in their respective operations in the Port of Providence, it was ascertained that these tow boats often are not available as their area of operation extends to various parts of the Providence Harbor and Narragansett Bay, including the Naval Air Station at Quonset Point and often the Harbor of Fall River, Massachusetts.

It was further developed that in the opinion of these same individuals, there is no necessity for the outfitting of such crafts for additional fire-fighting facilities along the harborline in Providence.

The equipping and maintaining of such a craft as a Municipally-owned fire boat, would be exorbitant in cost and would not effect the desired results.
