RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 796

Approved November 15, 1993

WHEREAS, Speeding has become a serious problem on our residential streets in the City of Providence, and

WHEREAS, Enforcement is usually found on the main thoroughfares through the use of FARE program and seldom on our residential streets, and

WHEREAS, The population of children is growing in the neighborhoods with the influx of immigrants into our city, and

WHEREAS, Because of the lack of play areas or green space in our neighborhoods, many small children play in or near the residential streets, and

WHEREAS, There have been children hit by speeding cars, and property damaged by excessive speeding, i.e., porches rammed and destroyed, fences knocked to the ground and automobiles owned by innocent bystanders destroyed,

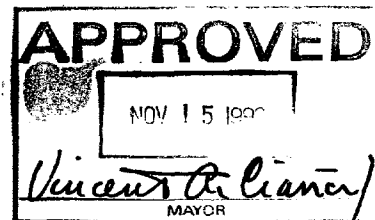
