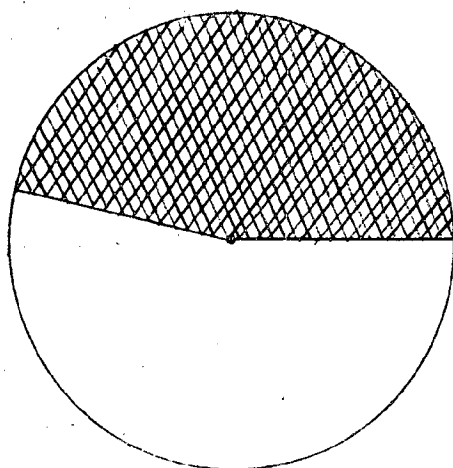

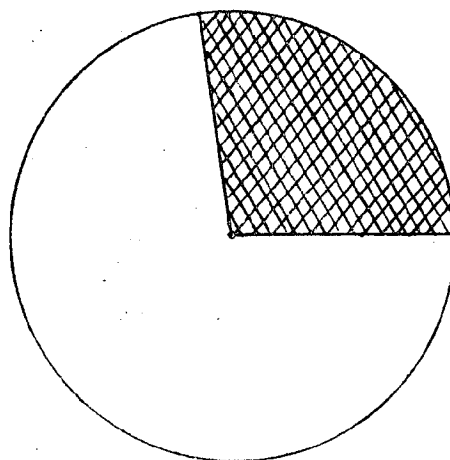

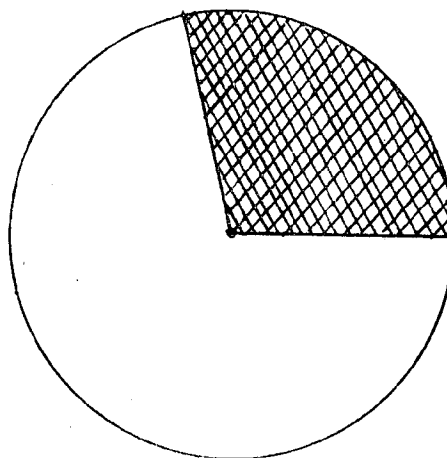

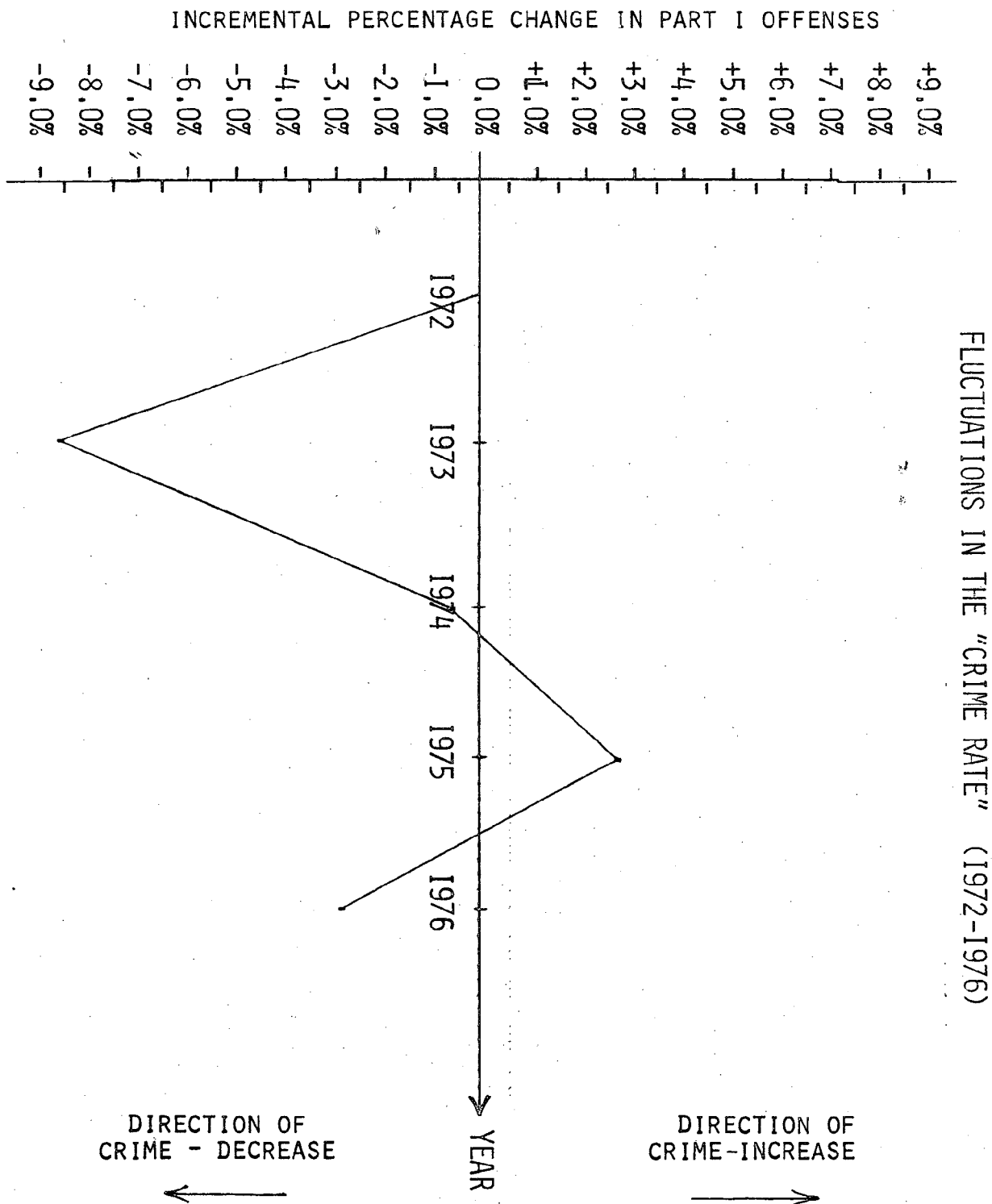

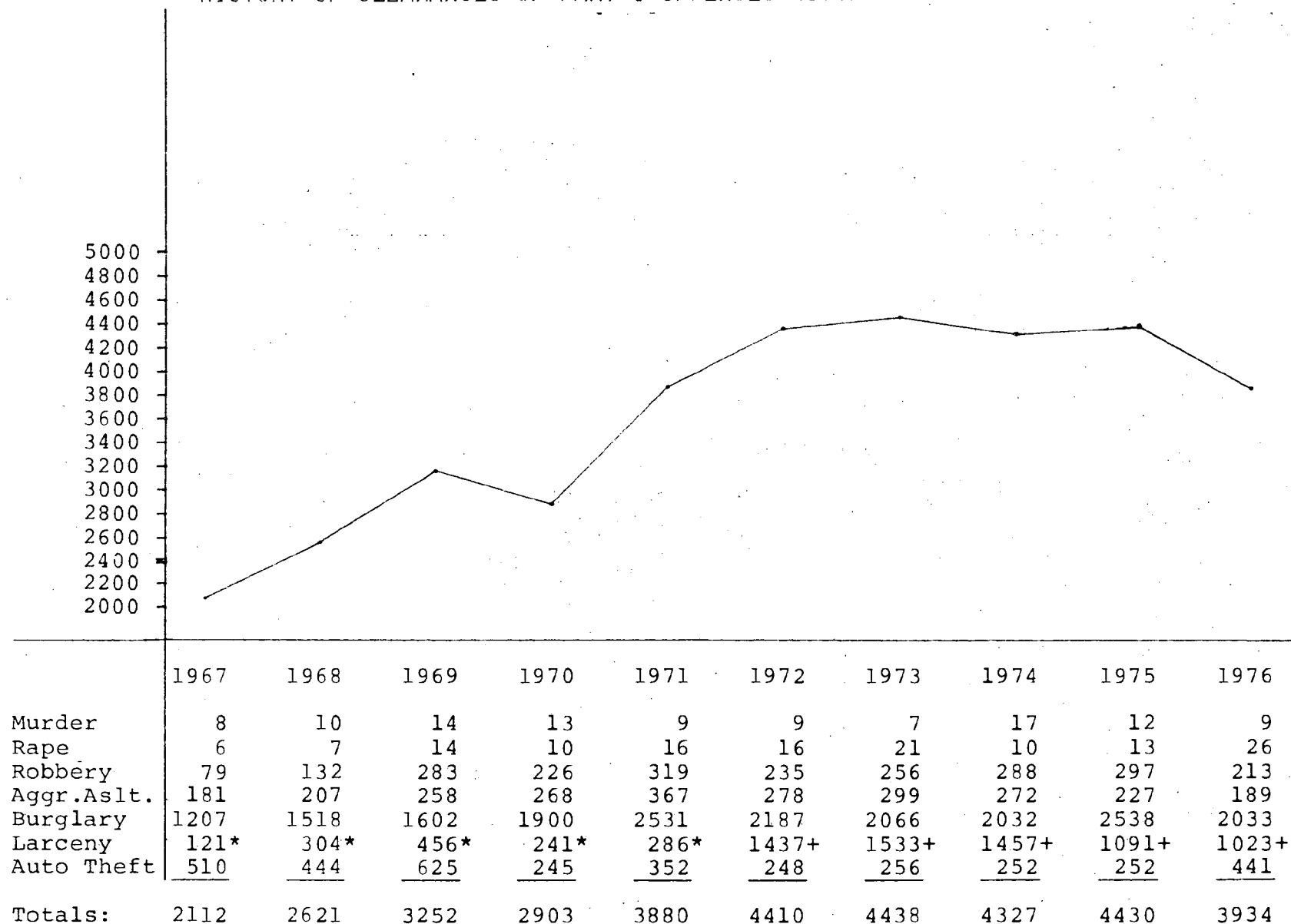
HISTORY OF PART I OFFENSES (1967 - 1976)

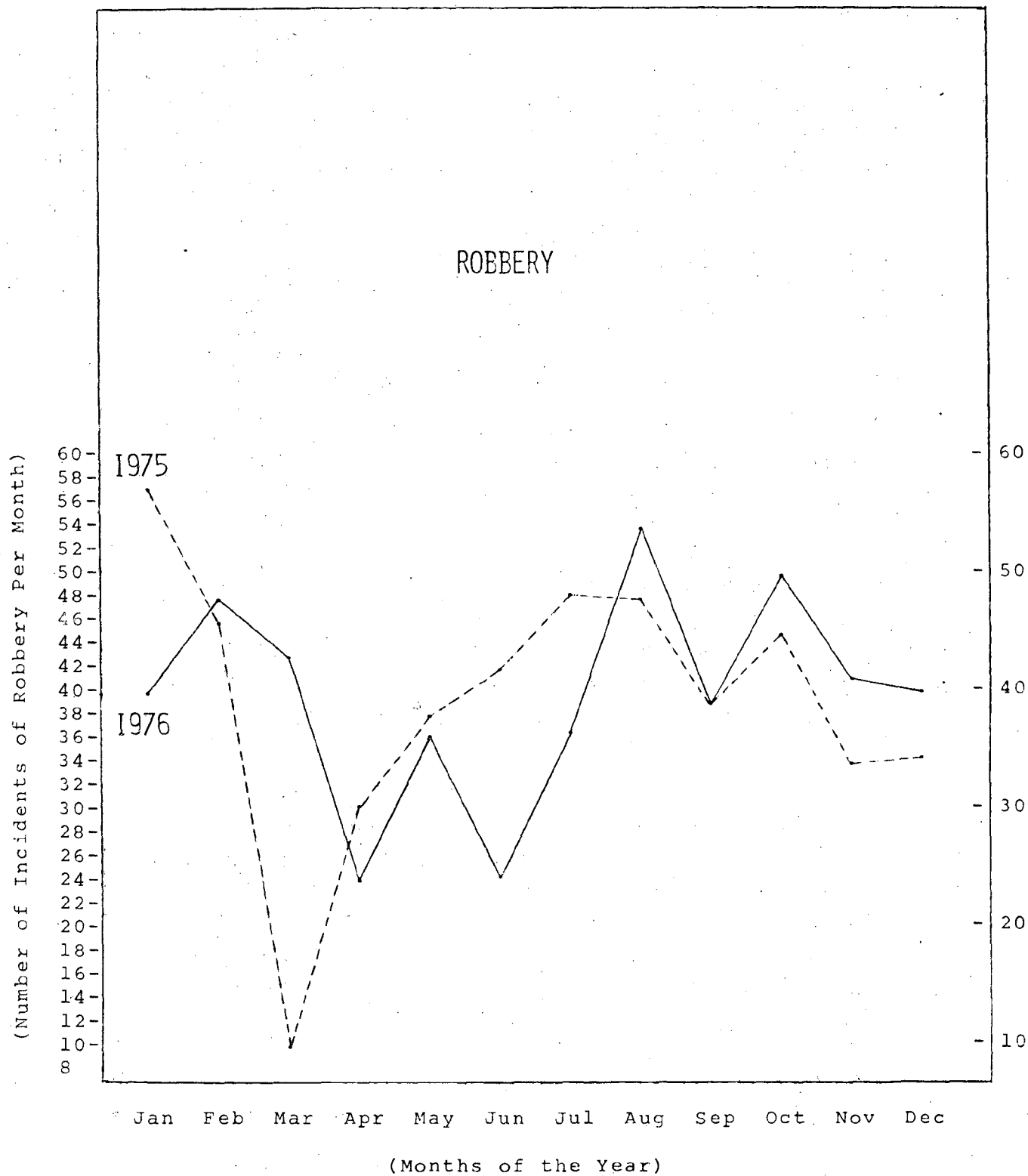
HISTORY OF CLEARANCES OF PART I OFFENSES (1967 - 1976)



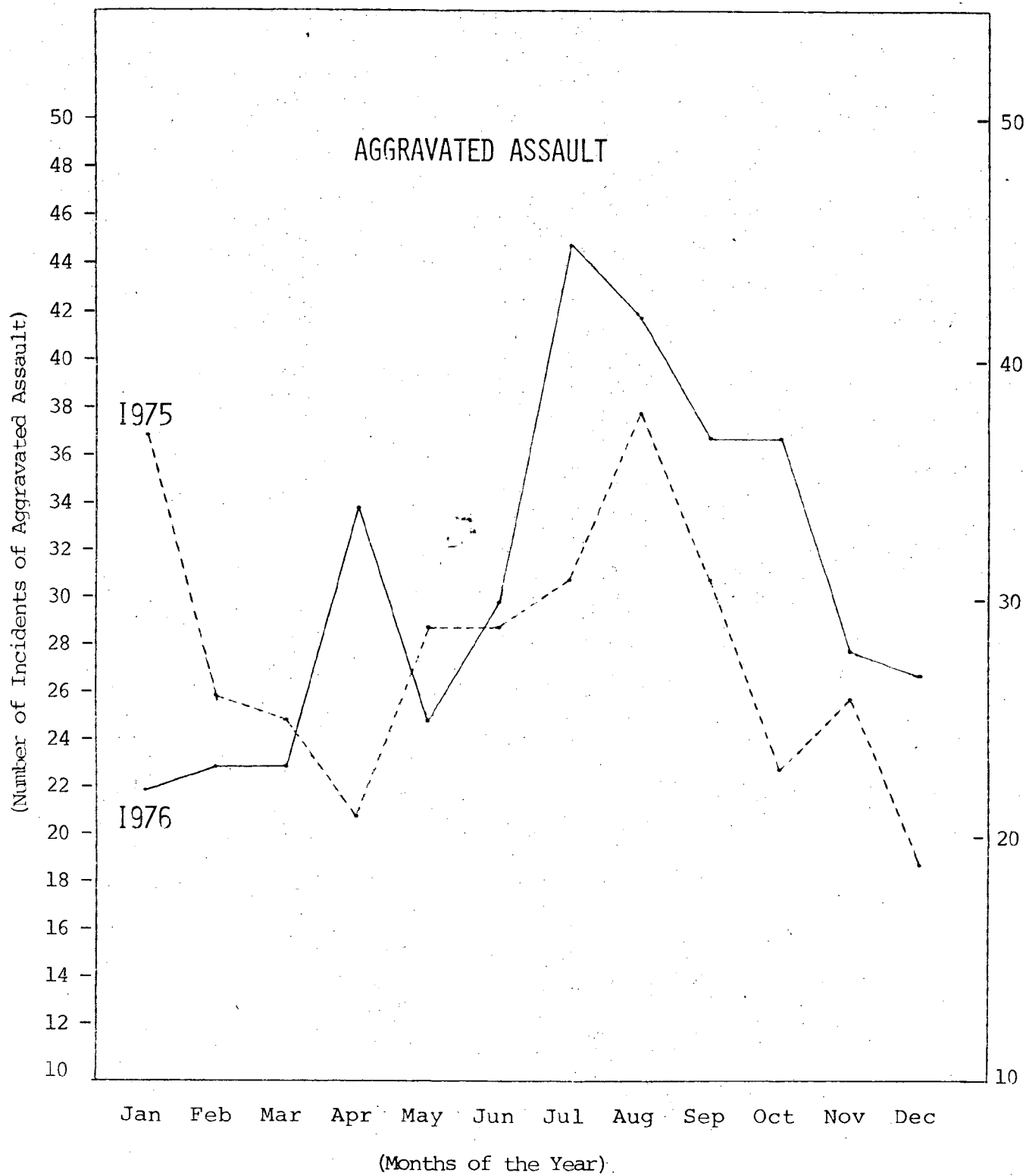

PART I OFFENSES: 1975 vs. 1976

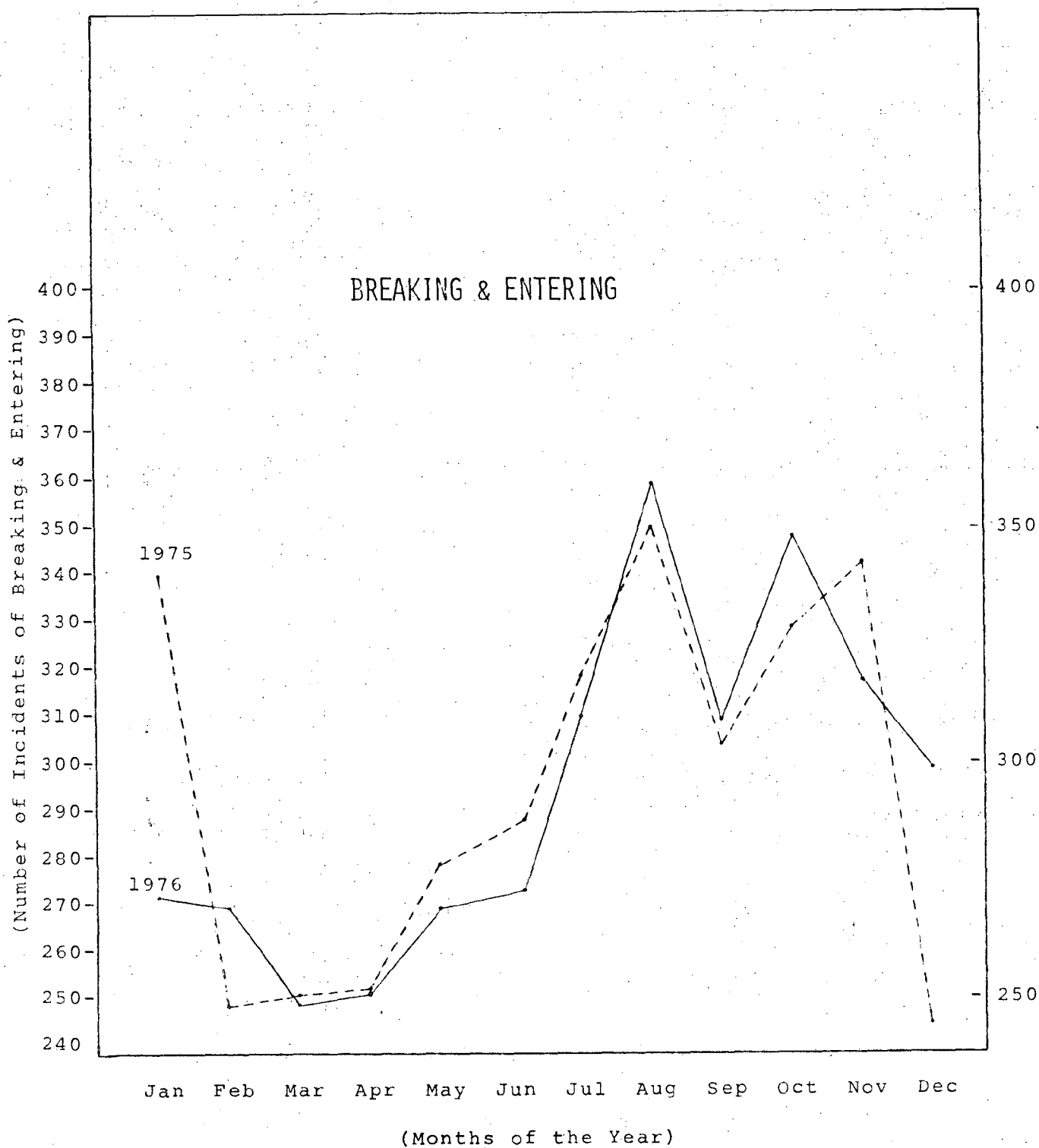
COMPARATIVE HISTORY OF ROBBERY

(1975 vs. 1976)



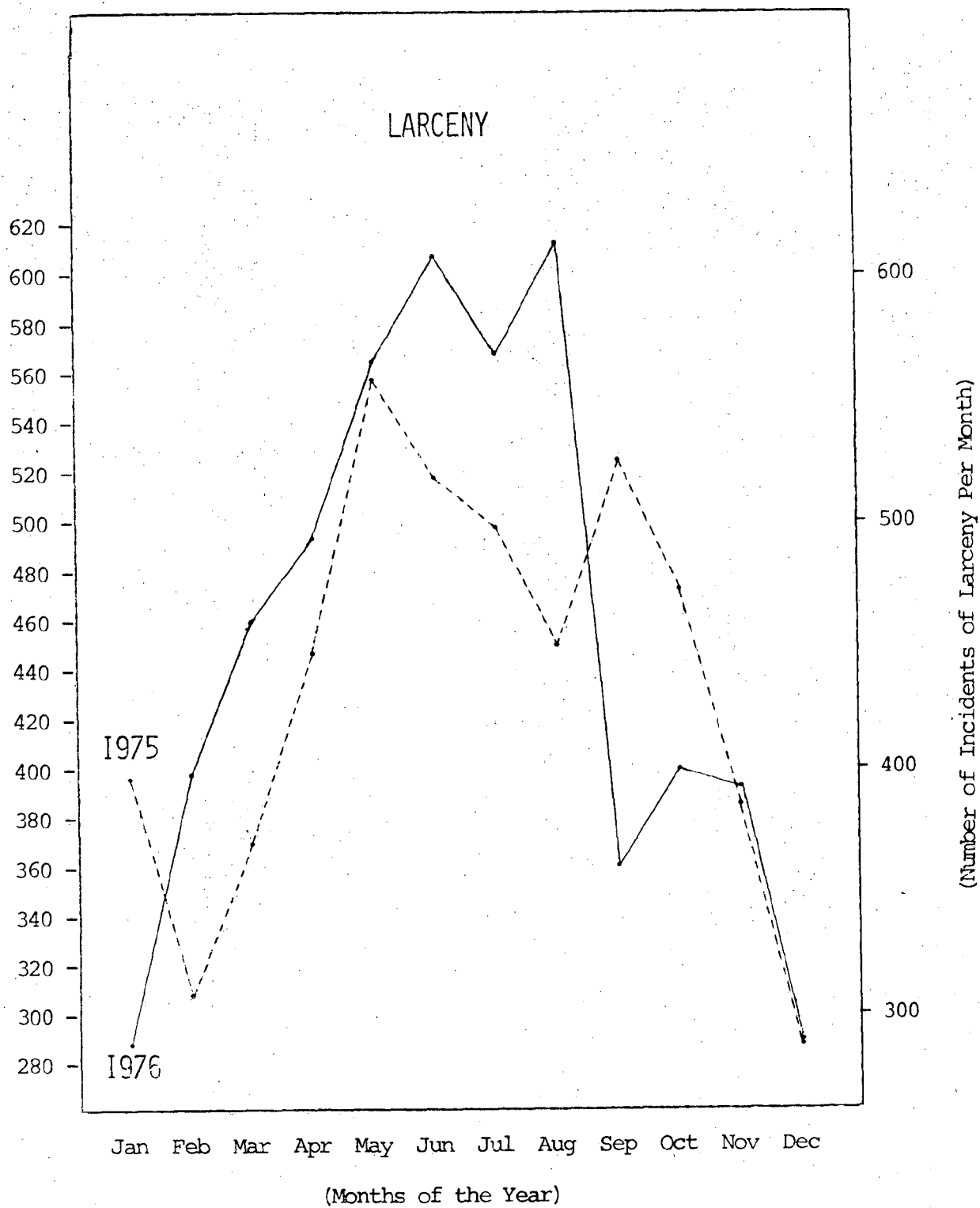
COMPARATIVE HISTORY OF AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

(1975 vs. 1976)

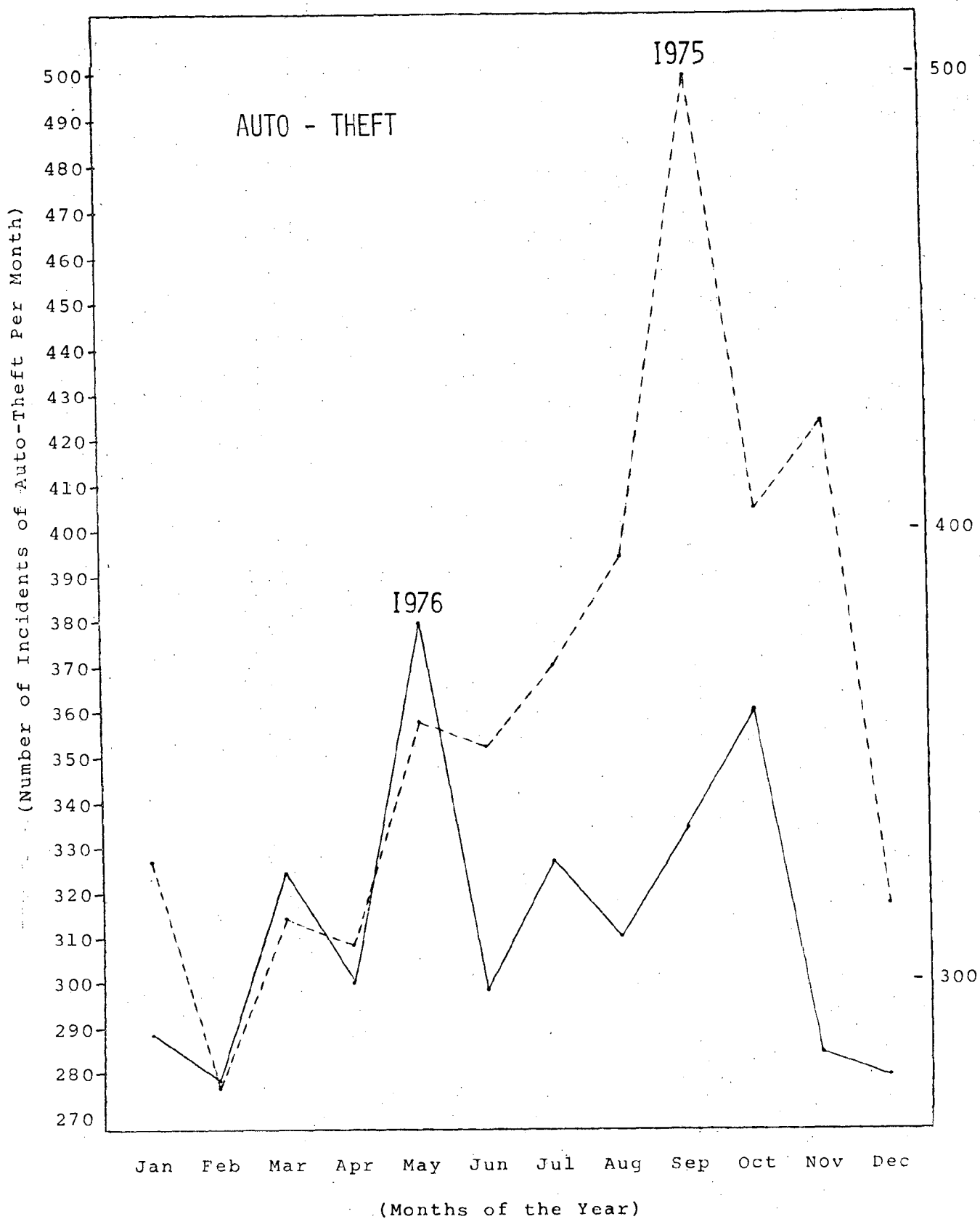

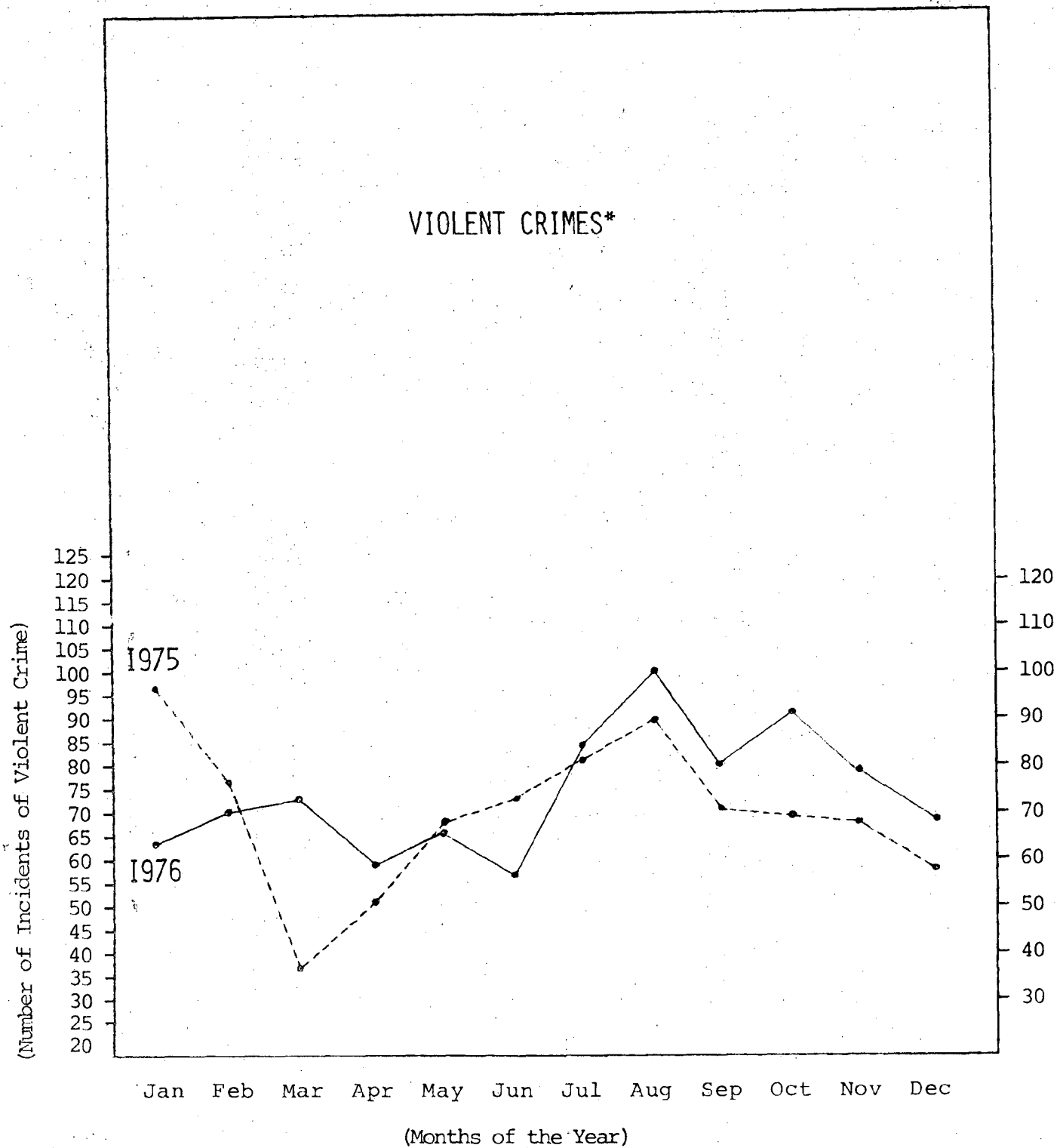

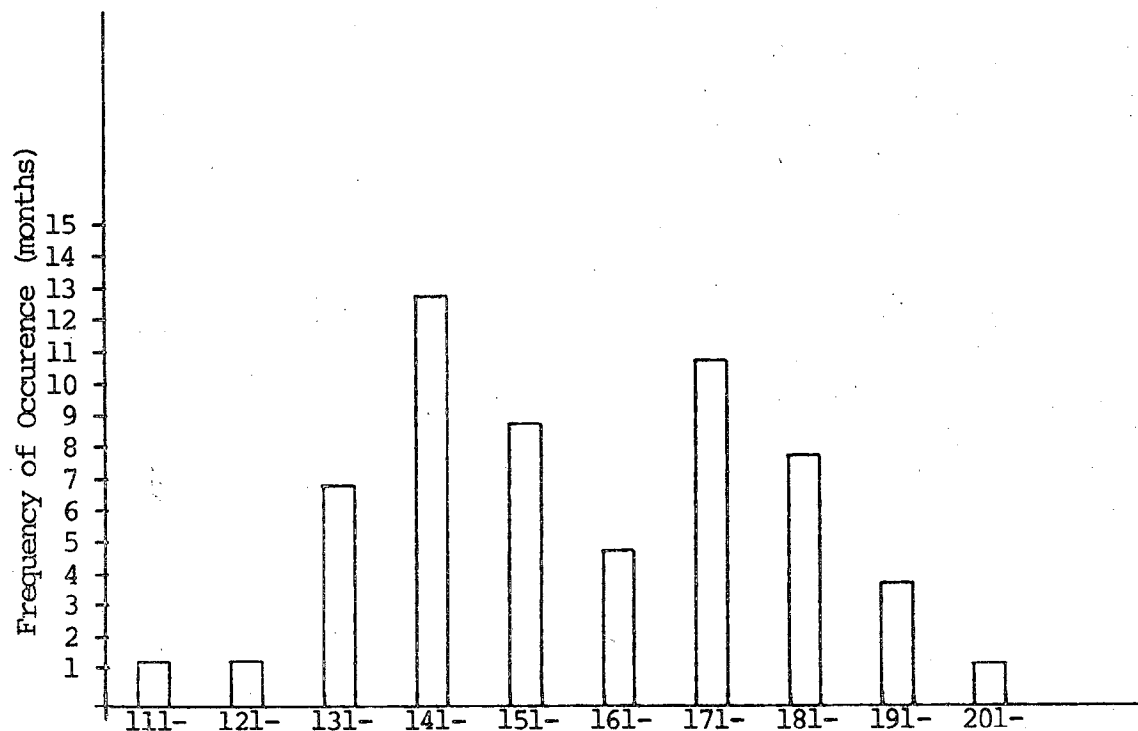
