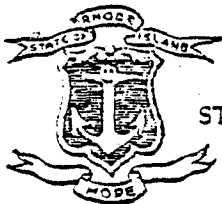

Under the following provisions: 1. Only work specifically shown on the aforementioned site plan is allowed. 2. Adequate measures are taken to prevent sediments from entering adjacent wetlands 3. Proposed compensatory excavation is accomplished prior to or concurrently with other work proposed in flood plain area.

it is our conclusion that this proposal represents an insignificant alteration of a fresh water wetland. Therefore, under the aforementioned provisions, a permit to alter fresh water wetlands will not be required.
