WHEREAS, Coach Ahern began coaching and teaching at Mount Pleasant in 1965; and

WHEREAS, He won his first basketball championship for the school in 1980; and

WHEREAS, For many decades Coach Ahern and his family welcomed athletes and students into their home, which became a focal point in the Silver Lake neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, His unwavering commitment to his community and to young people in Providence are indeed worthy of honor and recognition.




