No. 331 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
CHAPTER 1489, BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TEN THOUSAND
(\$10,000) DOLLARS TO MUNICIPAL DOCKS, ITEM 1.

Approved May 3, 1963

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1489 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, as approved September 21, 1962 entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$43,334,668.75 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1963", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars to MUNICIPAL DOCKS, ITEM 1.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account are hereby increased by Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

AMENDATORY GRANT OFFER

This Amendatory Grant Offer by and between the City of Providence (herein called the "Applicant") and the Housing and Home Finance Agency, hereinafter referred to as the Government, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Grant Offer, dated January 31, 1963, and the Acceptance dated February 8, 1963, between the parties hereto, provided that, subject to the terms and conditions thereof, that the Government would make a grant of not to exceed \$90,000.00 in order to aid in financing the construction of essential public works or facilities estimated to cost \$180,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the public works and facilities has decreased from \$180,000.00 to \$114,600.00; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant and the Government have agreed to a reduction in the amount of the grant from \$90,000.00 to \$73,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant and the Government are desirous of amending the Grant Agreement as hereinafter set forth;



1. In line 4, change "\$90,000.00 to "\$73,000.00.
2. In line 8, change "\$180,000.00 to "\$114,600.00.
3. In line 11, change "\$180,000.00 to "\$114,600.00.

All the provisions, terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement shall remain in full force except as amended hereby.

This Amendatory Grant Offer by and between the City of Providence (herein called the "Applicant") and the Housing and Home Finance Agency, hereinafter referred to as the Government, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Grant Offer, dated January 31, 1963, and the Acceptance dated February 8, 1963, between the parties hereto, provided that, subject to the terms and conditions thereof, that the Government would make a grant of not to exceed \$20,000.00 in order to aid in financing the construction of essential works or facilities estimated to cost \$40,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the public works and facilities has decreased from \$40,000.00 to \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant and the Government have agreed to a reduction in the amount of the grant from \$20,000.00 to \$12,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant and the Government are desirous of amending the Grant Agreement as hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual benefits flowing to the Applicant and the Government, the aforesaid Grant Offer is hereby amended as follows:

1. In line 4, change "\$20,000.00 to "\$12,500.00.
2. In line 8, change "\$40,000.00 to "\$25,000.00.
3. In line 11, change "\$40,000.00 to "\$25,000.00.

All the provisions, terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement shall remain in full force except as amended hereby.
