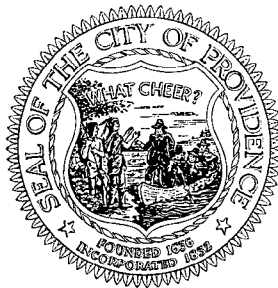

PETITION FOR MODERATE GREENS FEES  
AT TRIGGS MEMORIAL GOLF COURSE

TO: The Honorable Joseph A. Doorley Jr.  
The Honorable City Council  
The Honorable Park Commissioners

The undersigned golfers, taxpayers and friends of public golf in Rhode Island respectfully urge that the present greens fees be maintained at Triggs Memorial Golf Course.

The Triggs course is the only available facility for public golfers in Providence and many surrounding Towns. The present greens fees are slightly high when compared to those of other comparable public courses in New England. For instance, New Haven's public course charges \$30 for a season pass to a resident of the city. In Springfield the charge is \$35 and in Hartford \$40. Our fees are now \$70 for residents and \$125 for non-residents.

Certainly rate increases would place our own facilities in poor comparison with these other public golf courses.

We also feel that season passes should be valid from January 1st. to December 31st or as long as the municipal course stays open. Season pass holders should not have to pay extra greens fees after the end of what is arbitrarily termed "the regular season".

We will be thankful for your full consideration of these requests.


