STREETS

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, September 10, 1957.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning from an R-4 Zone to a C-4 Zone Lots 172, 174 and 207 on Assessor's Plat 23 located on Friendship and Lockwood Streets, the area in question contains 10,344 square feet of land.

On the field trip it was found that the area in question is occupied by a drugstore and two apartments, vacant parking lot and a four apartment house.

The granting of this petition would create a heavy commercial use in a residential zone, creating a new case of spot zoning, which would adversely affect the adjoining and surrounding residential properties. Therefore,
