




This Department has requested Narragansett Electric to upgrade all the lights on Sessions Street to 27,500 lumen HPS fixtures on March 1, 1993. This work will be completed by March 1994. At that time if the street needed additional lighting, a light will be placed on the pole opposite 41 Sessions Street. However, since these lights are brighter than the existing lights the additional light will probably not be needed.
