viz:

to abandon as a Public Highway, that portion of O'Connor Street, from Jillson Street to Broom Street, depicted on the above noted and accompanying plan as cross-hatched area, having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is proposed to be abandoned as a public highway, subject to any easements required by the Department of Public Works and of any private utility, and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, that after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.




Dear Councilman Flynn:

SUBJECT: Referral No. 1951 - ABANDONMENT PORTION O'CONNOR STREET

Gentlemen:

This petition from the Committee on Public Works proposes the abandonment of a portion of O'Connor St. from Jillson St. to Broom St. The petition was initiated by Councilman John P. Garan acting for the Board of Directors of the Washington Park Community Center.

Inspection revealed that the roadway in question is flanked on the west by a lot containing a branch of the Providence Public Library and by five vacant lots on the east. On the basis of the information as presented this department was unable to make a determination as to the advisability of the abandonment.

However, after consultation with the Office of Community Development, we were informed that the OCD has an option to purchase the five adjoining lots (No. 362, 363, 364, 365 and 366) and two additional lots (265 and 252) on Plat 58 for the sum of \$35,000 for the purpose of constructing a Community Center building. The street abandonment would presumably increase the area of the grounds.

Based on this information, this department has no objection from a planning standpoint to the proposed abandonment provided that the City traffic Engineer approves of the revised traffic routing caused by the abandonment.

No objection is offered by this department to the granting of the petition.




