CHAPTER 1066

No. 518 **AN ORDINANCE** REQUESTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO
SUBMIT FIVE (5) QUESTIONS TO THE VOTERS AT THE GENERAL
ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE TUESDAY NEXT AFTER THE FIRST
MONDAY IN NOVEMBER, A. D. 1956.

Approved October 5, 1956

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State is hereby requested to submit the following five (5) separate questions to the qualified electors of the City of Providence at the general election to be held in said City on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in November, A. D. 1956, namely:

- (1) Shall Chapter 3657 of the Public Laws of Rhode Island 1956 be approved and the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds in a sum not exceeding NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$900,000.00) DOLLARS for the repair, reconstruction and replacement of the sewage treatment plant of the City of Providence, in addition to bonds heretofore authorized in the sum of THREE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$3,500,000.00) DOLLARS for said purpose by Chapter 3049 of the Public Laws of 1953, as provided in said Act?
- (2) Shall Chapter 3638 of the Public Laws of Rhode Island 1956 be approved and the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds in a sum not exceeding ONE MILLION (\$1,000,000.00) DOLLARS for school modernization, as provided in said Act?
- (3) Shall Chapter 3639 of the Public Laws of Rhode Island 1956 be approved and the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds in a sum not exceeding ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$1,250,000.00) DOLLARS for school purposes, as provided in said Act.
- (4) Shall Chapter 3679 of the Public Laws of 1956 be approved and the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds in a sum not exceeding ONE MILLION (\$1,000,000.00) DOLLARS for highway purposes, as provided in said Act.
- (5) Shall Chapter 3680 of the Public Laws of Rhode Island 1956 be approved and the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds in a sum not exceeding FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$500,000.00) DOLLARS for sewer purposes, as provided in said Act.

No. 520 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 544 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 21, 1951, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED, IS HEREBY FURTHER AMENDED, BY CHANGING FROM A C-2 GENERAL COMMERCIAL ZONE TO A C-4 HEAVY COMMERCIAL ZONE LOT 254 AS SET OUT AND DELINEATED ON CITY ASSESSOR'S PLAT 112; SAID LOT BEING LOCATED ON THE NORTHEASTERLY CORNER OF PLAINFIELD AND KILLINGLY STREETS AND DESIGNATED AS 615 PLAINFIELD STREET.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height, and Area Regulations" is hereby further amended by changing from a C-2 General Commercial Zone to a C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone Lot 254 as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 112; said lot being located on the northeasterly corner of Plainfield and Killingly Streets and designated as 615 Plainfield Street, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the northwesterly corner of Plainfield and Killingly Streets; thence westerly along the northerly line of Plainfield Street to the southwesterly corner of Lot 254 on Assessor's Plat 112; thence northerly along the easterly line of Lot 253 to the northwesterly corner of Lot 254; thence easterly along the southerly line of Lot 255 to the westerly line of Killingly Street and the northeasterly corner of Lot 254; thence southerly along the said westerly line of Killingly Street to the point and place of beginning.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SUBJECT: Referral No. 821 - ZONING CHANGE LOCATED AT CORNER OF PLAINFIELD AND KILLINGLY STREETS

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, June 12, 1956.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning from a C-2 Zone to a C-4 Zone of Lot 254 on Assessor's Plat 112 located at corner of Plainfield and Killingly Streets. The area in question contains a total of 8,696 square feet.

Reference is made to Referral No. 464, from the Committee on Ordinances, dated February 25, 1953, which requested a change in zoning from an R-3 Zone to a C-4 Zone of Lots 144, 145, 146, 254 and 324 on Assessor's Plat 112. It was recommended by the City Plan Commission that the properties be rezoned for C-1 use and City Council approved the petition for C-2 use.

On the field trip it was found that the area in question is occupied by a four-family dwelling.

There is more than ample C-4 zoning in this area to warrant expanding or adding to it. Therefore,

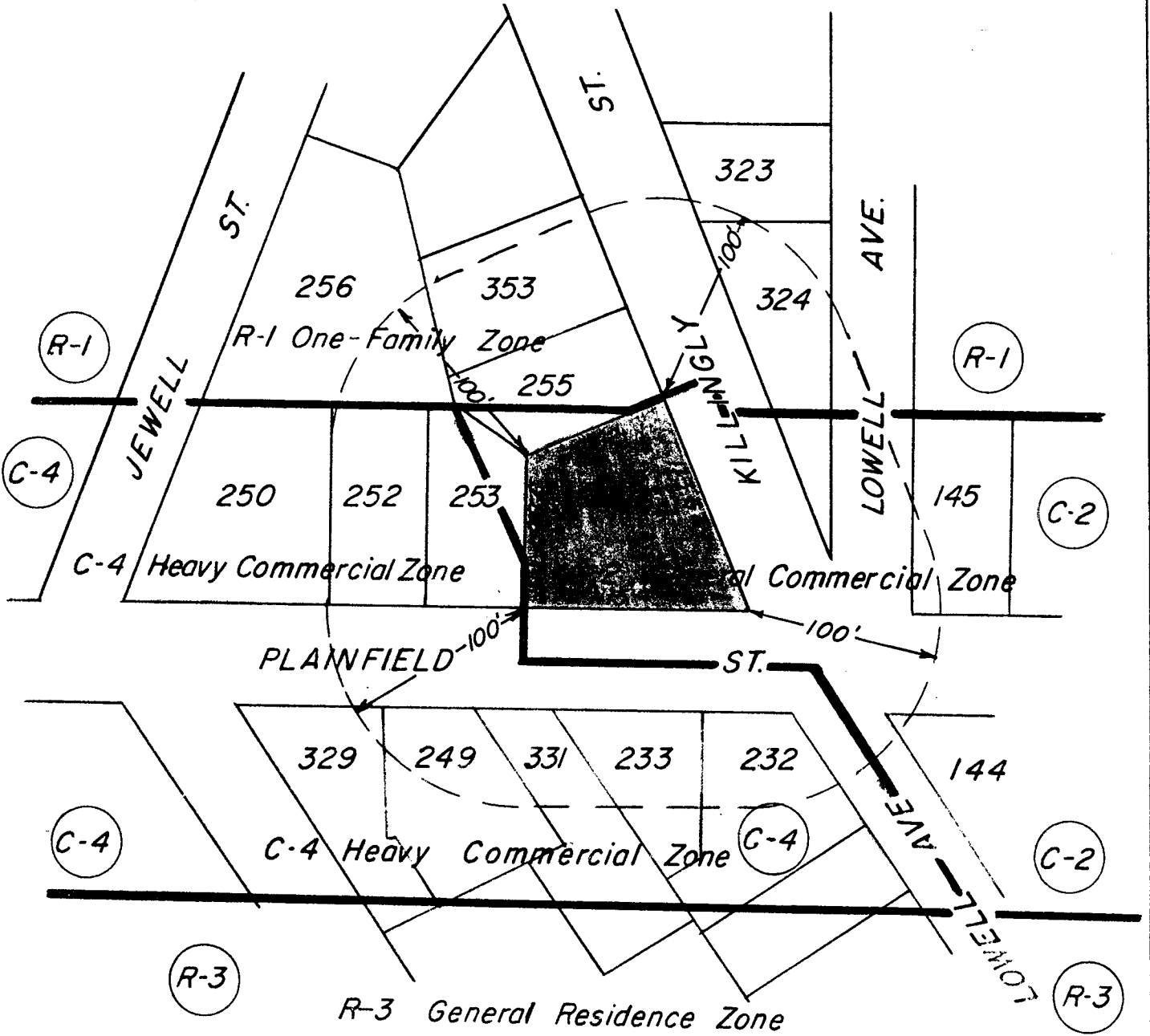
Shaded area to be changed from a
