No. **134 AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING CHAPTER 886 BY APPROPRIATING  
THE SUM OF SEVENTY ONE HUNDRED (\$7100) DOLLARS TO PUBLIC BUILDINGS  
SECTION, ITEM 6.

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1: Chapter 886 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence

As approved September 17, 1954, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$30,448,534.47 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1955", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Seventy One Hundred (\$7100) Dollars to PUBLIC BUILDINGS SECTION, ITEM 6.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Seventy One Hundred (\$7100) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3: The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Seventy One Hundred (\$7100) Dollars.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

I would like to add an arrow, constructed of 24 gauge galvanized iron, with scintillating lamps to existing section of marquee where I will remove porcelain channel letters.

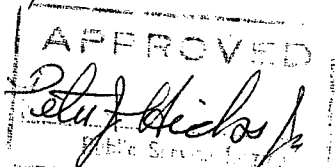
I feel that this work will not be a hazard to the building or the City of Providence.

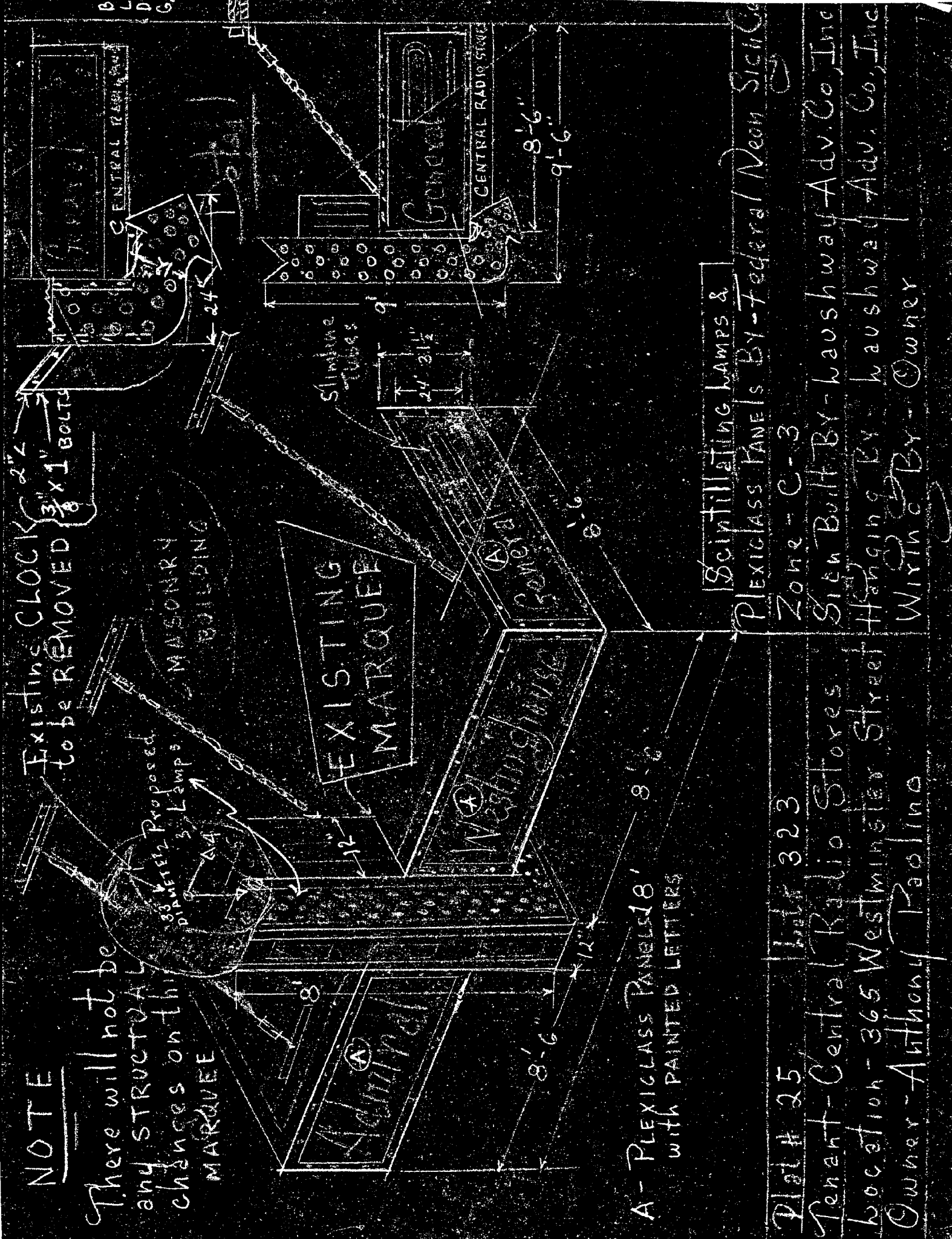

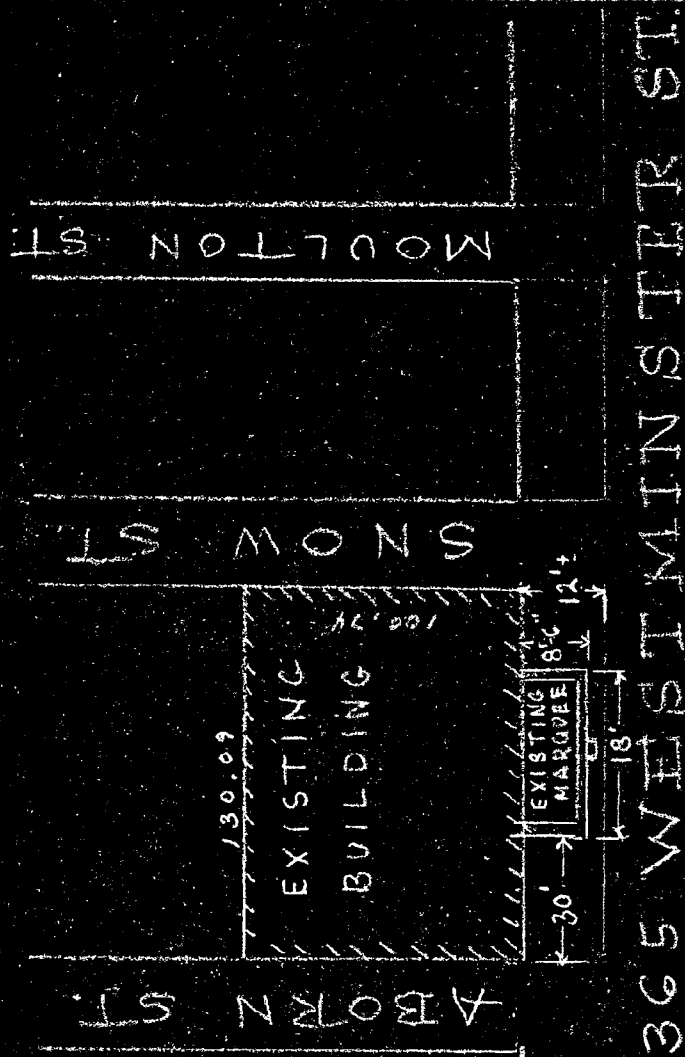
