RESOLVED, That the following Minute of the life and character of the late Miguel C. Luna, Member of the Providence City Council from January 6, 2003 to August 18, 2011 is hereby adopted, ordered, and inscribed on the records of the City Council and a duly certified copy be transmitted to the family of the deceased.

MINUTE

Miguel C. Luna, a native of San Pedro de Macoris, Dominican Republic, was born on March 2, 1958, to Mireya (Perez) Luna and the late Miguel D. Luna.

Miguel, a longtime Elmwood resident, was a founding member of the community organization Direct Action for Rights and Equality (DARE), and was involved with such community organizations at the International Institute, Jobs with Justice, the Olneyville Neighborhood Association, Amos House, the San Miguel School, and the Center for Minority Advancement in the Building Trades.

Having attended Community College of Rhode Island and Rhode Island College, Miguel served on the City Council representing Ward 9, and was the second Latino Councilman in Providence's history.

Miguel C. Luna, a dedicated public servant, was instrumental in the creation of the civilian police review board, the Providence External Review Authority (PERA), and was a champion in his efforts to protect affordable housing, create new jobs and make government more accessible to all residents. He was known for his generous heart and was often called a "councilman of the state".

A devout father, Miguel's devotion to his three children, Dante, Sofie and Omar, was infinite.

With his passing, Miguel C. Luna will be missed and mourned by his legion of friends and associates to whom he has bequeathed a wealth of fond and wonderful memories and may God, in His Wisdom, bestow upon Miguel C. Luna, Eternal Rest and to his family, peace and tranquility.


