Gentlemen:

This department has made a traffic survey of the intersection of Park Street and Promenade Street, and has determined that presently this intersection would warrant a traffic signal control, however, the proposed construction of the Civic Center Interchange would eliminate the Park Street on ramp and be reducing the volume of traffic on Park Street.

It should also be noted that the Park Street on ramp is closed due to construction on Interstate I-95 in that area. We do not feel that it would be economically justified to install a traffic signal which would be usefull for such a short period of time.
