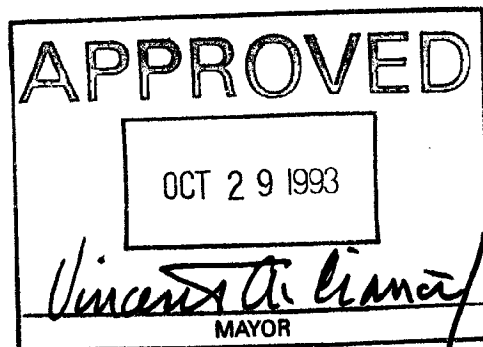

RESOLVED, That the Providence Public Library ("PPL") is granted permission to construct and maintain a single flagpole abutting its entrance located on Empire Street, Provided, however, that said grant is specifically conditioned upon:

1. Said construction is performed in accordance with the plans and specifications submitted by PPL to the City Department of Inspection and Standards, as said plans may have been modified by said Department.
2. PPL supplying a certificate of insurance, in an amount not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00), listing the City of Providence, its officers, servants, agents, and assigns, as an additional named insured.
3. PPL executing an indemnification and hold-harmless agreement substantially in the form as attached as Exhibit "A."

INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

It is agreed between PROVIDENCE PUBLIC LIBRARY (hereafter "PPL") and the CITY OF PROVIDENCE (hereafter the "City") that for One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, PPL, its agents, servants, assigns and successors in interest, shall forever indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers, agents, servants, employees and assigns, from any claim, dispute or causes of action, whether relating to damage to third persons, their agents, servants, employees or assigns, or to their property, arising out of the construction, maintenance and/or existence of a flagpole on that city sidewalk abutting Empire Street.

PPL further agrees to defend any such claim, dispute or cause of action against the City, its officers, agents, servants, employees or assigns, in a timely manner, and should it fail to do so, the City may, at its option, defend such claim, dispute or cause of action, and should the City elect to so defend, PPL shall, in any event, remain liable for the costs of such defense including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees, and any resulting, finding, decision or judgment against the City.

The undersigned warrants he/she is authorized to execute this document on behalf of PPL and that such execution is in accordance with all by-laws or rules of said PPL.

Section 608 - Non-Conforming Signs: Any sign which lawfully existed and was maintained at the time this Ordinance became effective, may be continued. Maintenance, repairs and changing of sign faces are permitted provided that there is no change in area, height, setback, projection or lighting of the existing sign.

Section 609 - Supplemental Sign Regulations:

609.1 - Signs in Historic Districts: All signs, including window signs, in an Historic District shall be subject to approval by the Historic District Commission.

609.2 - Signs in I-1 and I-2 Overlay Zones: Wherever the I zones overlay a C, D, M, or W zone, signs shall conform to the corresponding requirements of the under-
