WHEREAS, The Providence Preservation Society will be holding its annual historic house tour on June 3, through June 5, 1988, it has requested that certain streets be closed off during certain hours in order to permit the tour to take place.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is hereby requested to close the below-listed streets during the respective below-listed times:

Friday, June 3 and Saturday, June 4, from 5 to 10 p.m.: Benefit Street from Thomas Street to Halsey Street; and the following side streets off said portion of Benefit Street to be closed from North Main Street to Wheaton Street or Pratt Street: Meeting Street, South Court Street, North Court Street, Cady Street, Bowen Street, Howland, Church and Star.

Saturday, June 4, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.: Cooke Street from Power Street to Waterman Street; Power Street from Governor Street to Hope Street; and the following side streets between Governor Street and Hope Street: Young Orchard Avenue, Benevolent Street, Manning Street and George Street.

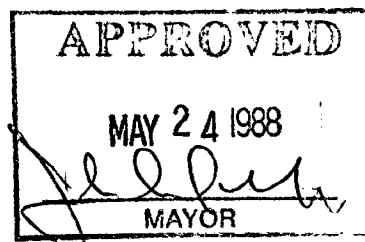
Sunday, June 5 from 12 noon to 4 p.m.: Melrose Street from Congress Street to Adelaide Avenue and the following streets between Melrose Street and Elmwood Avenue: Adelaide Avenue, Lexington Avenue, Ontario Street, Atlantic Avenue and Congress Avenue, and


40/44 Gladstone Street - No cars at location.
