

Dear Lori:

I am writing to request that the following requested contract awards be submitted to the City Council and the Finance Committee for approval:

- **Water Supply Board:**
  - Request to award **EDF Renewable Development \$18,208,039 and Klein Schmidt Associates \$200,000** for renewable energy over 20 years in accordance with Code of Ordinance Section 21-26.
- **Workforce Solutions:**
  - Request two one year extensions for **Comprehensive Community Action Program (CCAP) for \$700,000 per year** for the Workforce Investment Opportunity Act (WIOA) youth contracts in accordance with Code of Ordinance Section 21-26.
- **School Department:**
  - Request for a four year extension with **Aramark Management Services, L.P.** for the period of November 13, 2019 through November 12, 2023. Escalator for each of the extensions will be based on the CPI. The first year of the award, October 6, 2014, had a cost not to exceed **\$16,370,332** in accordance with the Code of Ordinances, Section 21-26.

RE: Extension of Award to Comprehensive Community Action Program (CCAP)

Dear Mayor Elorza:

Workforce Solutions of Providence Cranston respectfully requests two, one year extensions in the amount of \$700,000.00 for each year on the Workforce Investment Opportunity Act (WIOA) youth contracts approved on November 27, 2017, to Comprehensive Community Action Program (CCAP), 311 Doric Avenue, Cranston, RI 02910. The total request for extension is for \$700,000 per year, making the extension request \$1,400,000.00. See attached City Clerks letters for the original award.

Such extension is permitted through the contract language as well as the 2017 Request for Proposal of WIOA Youth Services:

*"Contracts resulting from this RFP are expected to begin July 1, 2017 and end June 30, 2019, with the option for renewal two times for up to two additional program years (through June 20, 2023) without further solicitation."*

The original award was in the amount of \$647,895.01, which was increased by \$52,104.99, making the new contract total, a not to exceed amount of \$700,000.00 per year. We are requesting two, one year extensions for \$700,000 for each year, totaling \$1,400,000.00

Funding Source for this award is from Federal grants, through fund 261.
