No. 511 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1982-42, APPROVED JULY 7, 1982, BY TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$450,000) DOLLARS FROM APPROPRIATION RESERVE TO SNOW REMOVAL.

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 1982-42 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, Approved July 7, 1982, Entitled: "An Ordinance making an appropriation of One Hundred Fifty-Eight Million, Two Hundred Forty One Thousand, Six Hundred Seventeen Dollars and Sixty-Nine Cents ( \$ 158,241,617.69 ) for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1983", is hereby amended by transferring the sum of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$450,000) Dollars from Appropriation Reserve (13-20-399) to Snow Removal (5-10-164)

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.



Dear Councilwoman Brassil:

The Finance Department is requesting a transfer of \$450,000 within the 1982-1983 General Fund appropriation. This transfer would reduce the amount in the Appropriation Reserve Account by \$450,000 while increasing the Snow Removal appropriation by the same amount.
