


# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL





Dear Councilman Clarkin,

I'm pleased to be sending you the 2002 WaterFire season schedule. We are excited to announce that the Sovereign Plaza Ballroom and Verizon Jazz Stage are both returning.

We are seeking your help once again in arranging for permission for street closings to accommodate the crowds who attend WaterFire. In the past we have reviewed these street closings with Traffic Engineering, the Parks Department, the Police Department, RIPTA and the City Law Department and they have approved them. The streets are the same as last year. The exact details with the precise sections of street and the times affected for each night are appended. In brief the streets are:

College Street – the block between Memorial Blvd and North Main Street  
 Steeple Street – the block between Canal Street and North Main Street  
 Canal Street – the short one-lane connector from Steeple Street to Washington Street  
 Exchange Street – the block between Memorial Boulevard and Stillman Street  
 Westminster Street (only on ballroom nights) – from Memorial Blvd to Weybosset  
 Weybosset Street (only on ballroom nights) – from Custom House to Westminster  
 The parking lane closure is on Washington Street.

We will be announcing ten full WaterFire dates to the public later this week, but we expect to be able to announce a few more dates a bit later in the season. To avoid returning to you for additional permissions we are seeking permission for all of the following dates (if we are unable to hold the event we will notify Traffic Engineering and the Police Department to cancel the approved street closing.): May 4<sup>th</sup>, May 26<sup>th</sup>, June 7<sup>th</sup>, June 12<sup>th</sup>, June 22<sup>nd</sup>, July 6<sup>th</sup>, July 27<sup>th</sup>, August 10<sup>th</sup>, August 24<sup>th</sup>, August 31<sup>st</sup> (not yet confirmed), September 21<sup>st</sup> (not yet confirmed), October 5<sup>th</sup> and October 26<sup>th</sup> (not yet confirmed).
