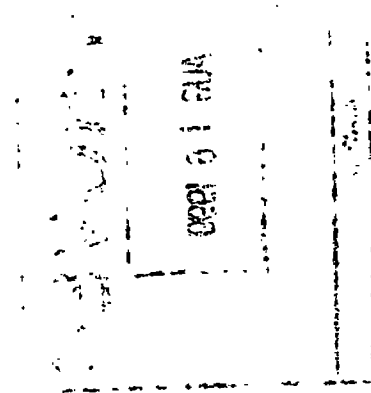

RE: PENDING MATTER

REQUEST: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of "20 MPH School Zone" signals along Eaton Street, from Wyndham Avenue to Hilltop Avenue to accommodate Saint Pius School.

DISPOSITION: At the present time, we are only planning on installing one flashing 20-MPH School Zone systems in each ward. There are funds allocated in Bond Monies that are not part of the 2.2 million per ward for this purpose. Since Narragansett Electric Company will not permit these devices to be attached to their poles, the cost of each system will go up dramatically due to the underground work. When the new bids come in I will be able to determine how many systems can be installed.
