No. 773 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1979-30, APPROVED JUNE 22, 1979, BY TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS, (\$22,000.00) FROM 5-350, WATER DEPRECIATION AND EXTENSION FUND, TO 1-16-03-612, IMPROVEMENTS TO BUILDINGS.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1979-30 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, Approved June 22, 1979, and entitled, "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of One Hundred Seventeen Million, Nine Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand, Seven Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars, Forty-Four Cents, (\$117,978, 739.44) for the support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1980, as amended", is hereby further amended by transferring a certain sum of money within the Water Supply Board, as follows:

FROM: 5-350 WATER DEPRECIATION and EXTENSION FUND \$ 22,000.00

TO: 1-16-03-612 IMPROVEMENTS TO BUILDINGS \$ 22,000.00

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage by the City Council and its approval by the Mayor.


