WHEREAS, This so-called property has been the complaints of many residents in the area, and

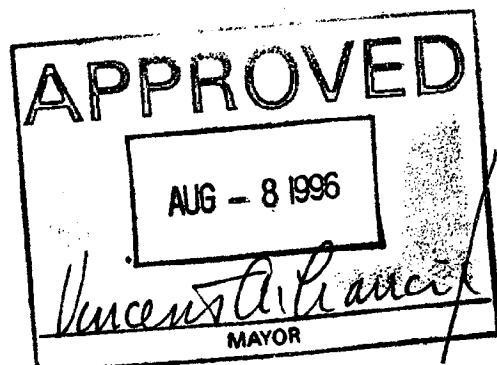
WHEREAS, Through some research, it was found that the Department of Planning has been contacted about the possibility of rehabilitating the said building, and

WHEREAS, It is requested that the Department of Planning and Development inform the Council person of the area as to the status of this building,

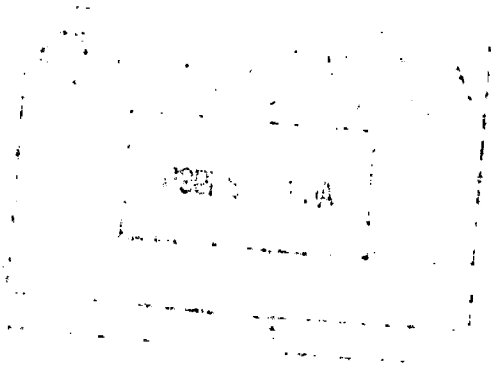

*Approved* August 8, 1996
