WHEREAS, the Providence School Committee proposed to transfer handicapped students presently attending classes at Almy Street Elementary School to Kenyon Street Elementary School, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the proposed handicap facilities at Kenyon Street Elementary School will not be completed as scheduled, since certain office space at Kenyon Street will be converted to classroom space after September of 1973; and, accordingly, would not be as adequate as at Almy Street Elementary School at present,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Providence School Committee is requested to continue and maintain the present facilities for handicapped students at Almy Street Elementary School at least through June of 1974.


