Whereas, the Public Utilities Division of the Department of Business Regulation did on January 4, 1961 grant to the Providence Gas Company a 200% increase in the minimum charge which it may impose upon its customers, and

Whereas said increase will, for the most part affect individuals and small family units which consume small quantities of gas and, in most instances, people of limited means, and

Whereas said increase was granted without public notice of the pendency of the application or a public hearing thereon, and

Whereas said increase appears prima facie to be unreasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the General Assembly be and it is hereby requested to take whatever action may be required to stay said increase and to investigate the reasonableness thereof, and

Be It Further Resolved that the City Clerk be directed to send a certified copy hereof to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and to the Lieutenant Governor as the presiding officer of the State Senate.

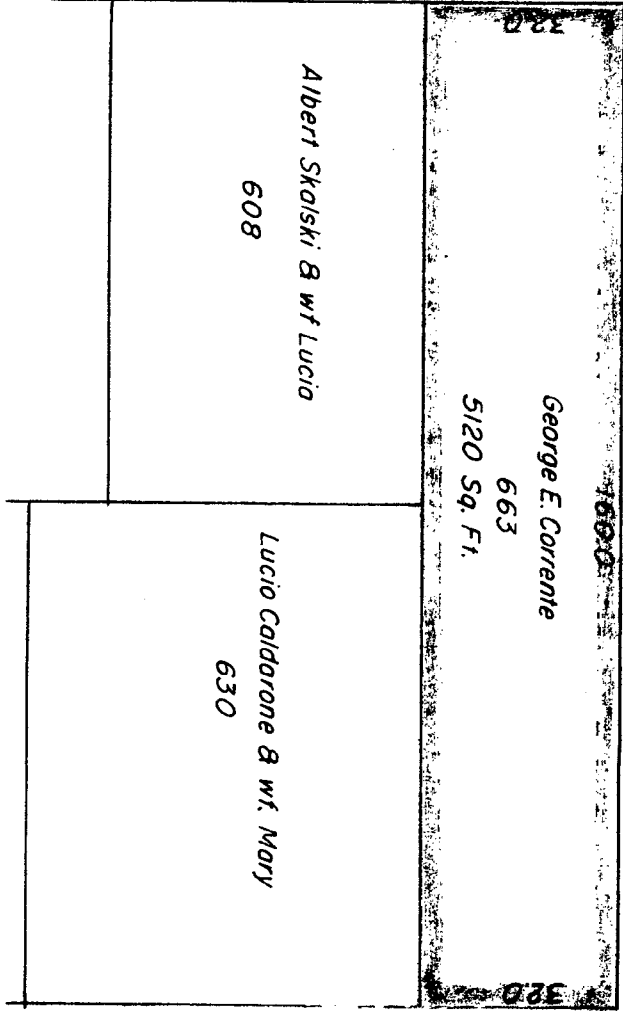
