Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1288 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 18, 1959, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$39,301,585.32 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1960", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars to PUBLIC CELEBRATIONS-FOURTH OF JULY.

SECTION 2. The said sum of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.





That part which has heretofore read: "The number of employees in the CIVILIAN DEFENSE COUNCIL shall not exceed three (3)"; shall hereafter read: "The number of employees in the CIVILIAN DEFENSE COUNCIL shall not exceed four (4)".
