Approved March 23, 1979

WHEREAS, Devoted to religious and civic affairs, he was a member of numerous Societies and Organizations to which he dedicated an immeasurable amount of time, and



WHEREAS, A lifelong resident of Providence, he was a Veteran of the United States Army during World War II,


