No. 2 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 544 OF 1951 BY CHANGING FROM AN R-3 GENERAL RESIDENCE ZONE TO A C-4 HEAVY COMMERCIAL ZONE, LOTS 632, 633 AND 634, AS SET OUT AND DELINEATED ON CITY ASSESSOR'S PLAT 65; SAID LOTS BEING SITUATED AT THE CORNER OF VALLEY STREET AND RILL STREET.

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height and Area Regulations", is hereby further amended by changing from an R-3 General Residence Zone to a C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone, Lots 632, 633 and 634, as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 65; said lots being situated at the corner of Valley Street and Rill Street, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the northwesterly corner of Valley and Rill Streets at the southeasterly corner of Lot 634 on City Assessor's Plat 65; thence generally southwesterly along the general northwesterly line of Valley Street to the southwesterly corner of Lot 633; thence northwesterly along the northeasterly line of Lot 613 to the southwesterly corner of Lot 632; thence northerly along the easterly line of Lot 631 to the southerly line of Boyd Street at the northwesterly corner of Lot 632; thence easterly along the northerly line of Boyd Street to its intersection with the westerly line of Rill Street; thence southerly along the westerly line of Rill Street to the northwesterly corner of Rill and Valley streets at the southeasterly corner of Lot 634 and the point and place of beginning.

Gentlemen:

This referral from the Committee on Ordinances is a petition for a zone change from R-4 to C-4 Lots 632, 633 and 634 in Assessor's Plat 65 at the westerly corner of Valley and Rill Streets.


On a photographic and inspection tour it was determined that Lots 633 and 634 are vacant and unimproved and Lot 632 is occupied by a 3-story frame dwelling in very poor condition. The neighborhood is industrial and heavy commercial with some remaining very badly deteriorated residential buildings.

The proposed zoning for this property is ML-2 (Light Manufacturing). The residual residential property in this area is in such bad condition that rehabilitation would be impractical and, in view of the nearby heavy commercial and industrial uses, inadvisable. Therefore,

WHEREAS, the tax liability on all property of the Boston & Providence R. R. Corp. and Providence & Worcester R. R. Co. and subject to tax by this municipality based on the assessment of valuation as of December 31, 1968 at the current rate of \$43.00 per thousand, amounts to \$21,620.83.

WHEREAS, the City of Providence wishes to avail itself of the benefits of the provisions of Section 7 of Chapter 46 of the Public Laws of 1961 as amended by Section 2 of Chapter 190 of the Public Laws of 1968; and

WHEREAS, the tax liability on all property of the Boston & Providence R. R. Corp., Cove Station and subject to tax by this municipality based on the assessment of valuation as of December 31, 1968 at the current rate of \$43.00 per thousand, amounts to \$64,876.25.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That said tax liability be and is hereby reduced to \$35,211.89 pursuant to and in conformity with the provisions of Section 7 of said Chapter 46 as amended by Section 2 of Chapter 190 of the Public Laws of 1968; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the City Treasurer be directed to report to the Chief of the Department of Community Affairs that the amount of such liability has been reduced to said sum of \$35,211.89, resulting in a reduction in such liability of \$29,664.36, to the end that he may certify to the state controller one-half (\$14,832.18) thereof for payment to this municipality.
