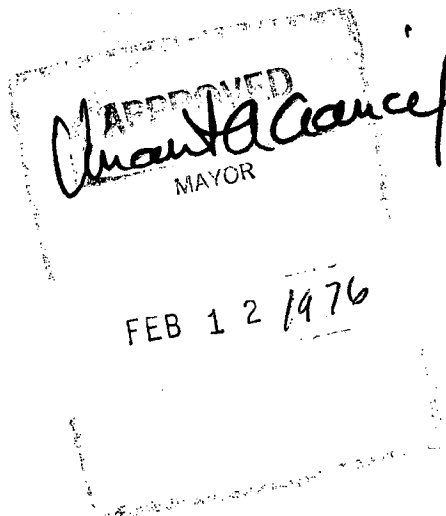
WHEREAS, Mr. Fricker continued his profession as a pharmacist, serving the needs of the people of the District he represented,
