



The Fleeing Felon Obstacle Course portion of a Mounted Police Competition

The Fleeing Felon Obstacle Course is made up of 10 obstacles that an Officer and his mount might encounter while in the routine performance of police duties. Some of the obstacles that are included are such as firing a weapon while mounted, bringing your horse through a debris field filled with hoses, flares, and tires which the horse must maneuver through, a construction site with a construction worker operating a jack hammer. In order to compete successfully in competition the officer has to demonstrate skills and convey confidence to his mount so that his mount will go forward in the face of danger.
