WHEREAS, by State acquisition of the former Fox Point Boulevard, which was named in his honor, the same has been obliterated,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in respect to the memory of the man who was awarded a Congressional Medal of Honor by the Government of the United States of America, acclaimed by the entertainment world and by all who enjoyed his work as a playwright, actor, and composer, Empire Park, so-called, is hereby designated as "George M. Cohan Memorial Park".
