WHEREAS, As Frank approached the young girl, he thought she was dead, because she was lying still, and

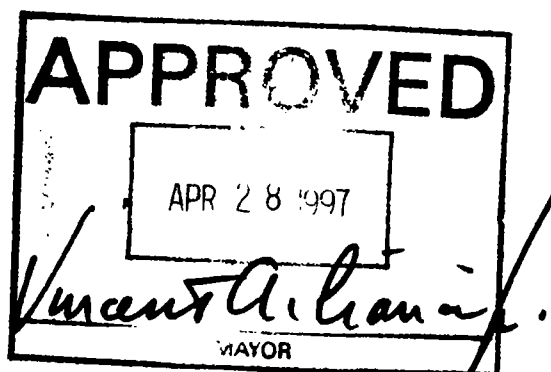

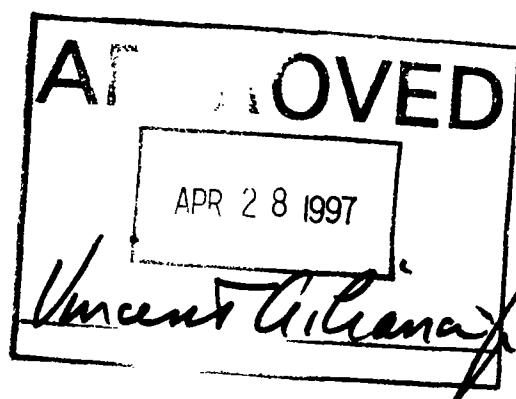
